# Anonymous funds encourage donations that will be matched

The St. Francis Community Foundation reports a \$50,000 anonymous matching fund donation for the Senior Living Fund for Cheyenne County for 2011.

The Community Foundation established a special interest fund for senior living needs in the county following the October fire at the Good Samaritan Village. Since the establishment of this fund, approximately \$64,000 has been donated.

The offer of the anonymous

\$50,000 matching funds was made on April 1. Since that date the Senior Living Fund has received \$17,000.

The most recent donation was \$8,150 raised by the Cheyenne County Hospital Benefit Golf Tournament on Aug. 27.

"If an additional \$33,000 can be raised before Dec 31, our community will receive the full benefit of the \$50,000 matching funds pledge," said Tom Keller, Foundation board president. "If

this pledge can be matched by year's end, there would be close to \$147,000 available in the fund to benefit our senior citizens."

The Senior Living Fund for Cheyenne County has a broad interpretation of possible uses. The most obvious use would be for the retention and improvement of long term care facilities in the county.

However, assistance with other senior living needs could include the Senior Center, as well as assistance in keeping seniors in their

homes as long as possible. People and organizations are asked to please consider making donation to the fund before year's end.
