Republicans will participate in Kansas Caucus on March 10

Republicans from all over Kansas will be participating in the Kansas Republican Caucus on Saturday, March 10. Cheyenne County registered Republicans are also encouraged to participate by coming to the St. Francis Community High School cafeteria at 9:30 a.m. to sign in with the anticipation of the actual voting.

Those signing in must have government issued identification. One of the identifications that is acceptable is a driver's

license. They must also be registered by Feb. 17.

Once there, registered voters will hear from representatives of each still viable candidate and then vote. The meeting begins at 10 a.m. but polls will remain open until 1 p.m.

The caucus is designed to say to the Republican National Committee how much support the state of Kansas has for the various Republican candidates.

Kansas has 40 delegates to the National Convention and it will

take 1,144 delegates to nominate the ultimate GOP presidential candidate.

The caucus is different than the traditional primary in that it is run by the state party, paid for by contributions as opposed to the primary which is sanctioned and funded by taxpayers in the state. The last time a standard primary was held in Kansas was 1992.

Local results will be made known through *The Saint Francis Herald* and *Bird City Times*.

Fire burning at Bonny state park

A fire has been burning at Bonny Dam since Wednesday. As of Monday, firemen were still trying to put it out.

The fire apparently started at the river bridge west of Bonny on Highway 385 on Wednesday and Idalia firemen responded. Firemen thought the fire was contained, then high winds hit the area and it started back up on Saturday.

The National Weather Service out of Goodland, on Tuesday, reported strong winds and very dry conditions have caused several days of fire at Bonny Dam. A


smoke plume on the fire could be seen on the website. The weather service reported that the loop span nearly five hours on Sunday. Winds on that day were from the northwest and the animation showed the smoke being carried to several counties downwind.

The fire has apparently burned about a half-mile of the river bottom and burned grass, dry brush and trees around the west and

north part of the old lake.

Along with the Idalia volunteers, firemen from Wray, Joes, Kirk, Hale and Armel have joined in fighting the fire. Besides the wind hampering their efforts, there is rough terrain, soft ground and some pools of water. Area farmers have also been helping by using their equipment to disk around the fires in hopes of stopping it from spreading further.
