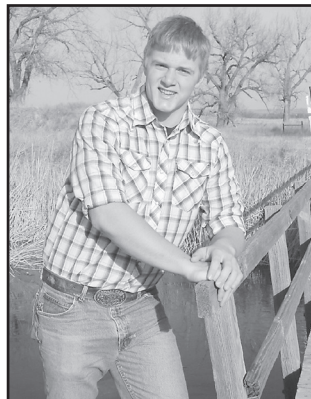

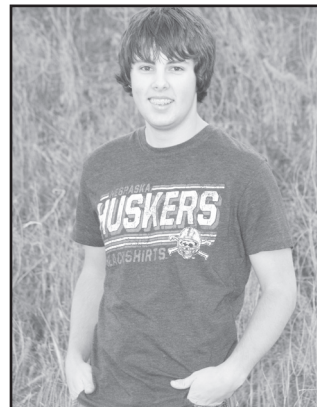
I plan to attend Colby Community College for a Criminal Justice degree then the Marine Corps. Eventually I hope to be a law enforcement officer.
