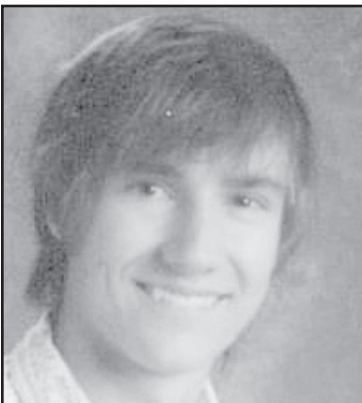


State music results in
