There has been a very good entry response again this year, said Marty Fear, Extension agent. Everyone is urged to come out and support the youth with their livestock.

There are four age divisions: senior (ages 14-19); intermediate (10-13); junior (7-9) and pee wee (6 and under).

Prizes of savings bonds will be awarded for grand and reserve champion market beef and

breeding heifer, grand and reserve champion pig and grand and reserve champion goat and lamb. In addition, belt buckles will be awarded to grand champions and plaques to reserve champions. Showman prizes will be awarded with cash payback.

Weigh in is from 8:30 a.m. to noon. The program begins with the swine showmanship and swine show, followed by the lamb show, goat showmanship, goat show, beef showmanship, heifer show and market steer and market heifer show.
