for the ladies. They also received Cheyenne Bowl/Dairy King gift cards and bottled water.

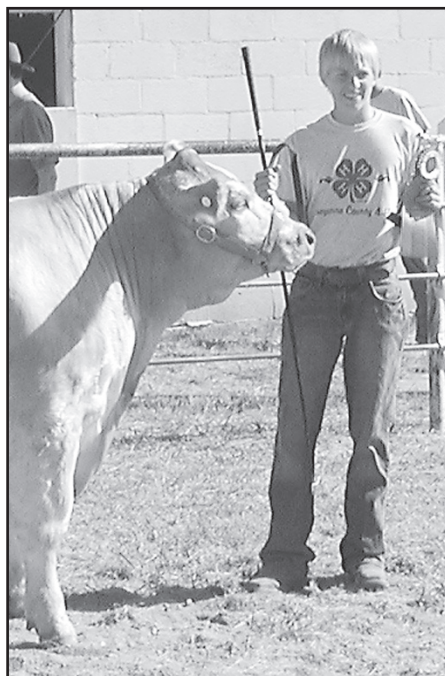

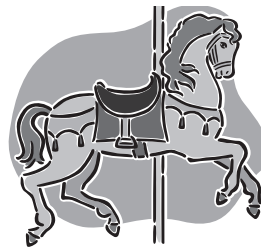
