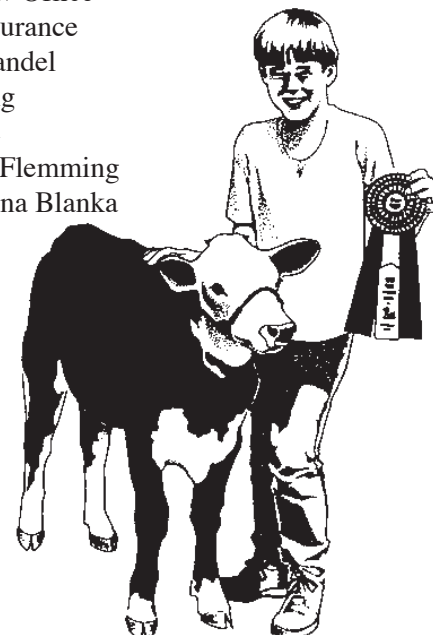

Carnival once again well attended at fair

The summer had been hot with day after day of 100-plus degrees but it cooled down in time for the fair. There have been few rain showers in St. Francis but on Wednesday, there was enough rain to close the carnival early. It was just right for riding the carnival rides and playing the games.

The Amusement Authority is made up by a board of volunteers who have been working on rides, painting and ordering prizes, since the carnival ended last year. Throughout the year, the members and volunteers made repairs.

However, the Authority now has only six members and they were having trouble getting the rides and games ready for the fair. Even a couple of weeks before the week of the fair, it was doubtful that all of the rides and games would be ready to go.

But, after several pleas for more help, volunteers began showing up for work. The painting was done, the rides were put together and the games were put together.

Volunteers, headed by board member, Susie Walz, managed to get all the fabulous prizes unpacked and put up. The prize booth is the most popular place during the fair, especially on Saturday when kids start turning in all the tokens they have accumulated for one or more prizes.

The carnival games and rides are also manned by volunteers but, as of the first day of the fair, it looked as though some of the rides and games would not be running on Saturday night, the busiest night of the fair. Raedell Winston had

volunteered to line up people to fill the roster of workers. Lucinda Straub also helped. Again, the people pulled through and almost all of the rides and games had volunteers.

It takes a village to make a carnival happen, Raedell said.

Greg Walz, member of the Amusement Authority, said the attendance was the same or even up this year.

Looking at the prizes, Mrs. Walz said, a big majority of them were purchased with tokens. "Overall, it was a good carnival," Mr. Walz said. "But, we couldn't put on four days of the carnival without all the people who help.

"No matter how big or small, the job every person did to get ready for the fair, is appreciated."

The authority members and volunteers will start working on equipment the first Thursday in September and will work each Thursday evening until it is too cold.

"We need people to help," he said. "Just come out and we will find things for people to do."

Mr. Walz, who has been helping at the carnival for over 20 years, said seeing the looks of enjoyment on people's faces, especially the children, is all the payment he needs.

"I see people sitting on the benches and they are enjoying talking with people who have come to the fair to do the same thing," he said. "Seeing these smiling people makes all the work we do throughout the year worthwhile!"

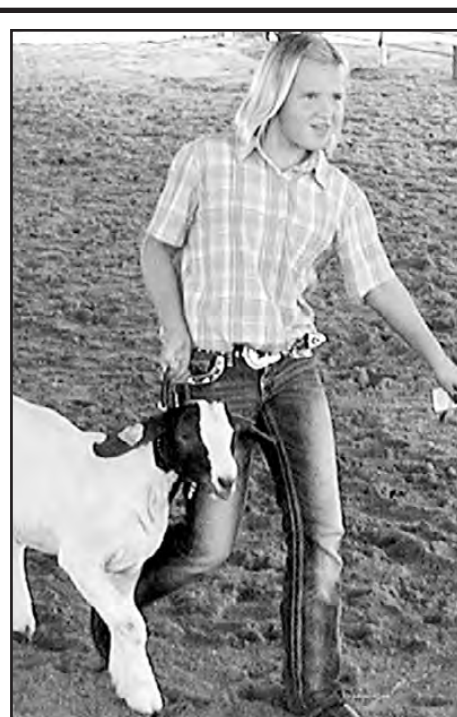

Premium sale total larger than last year's

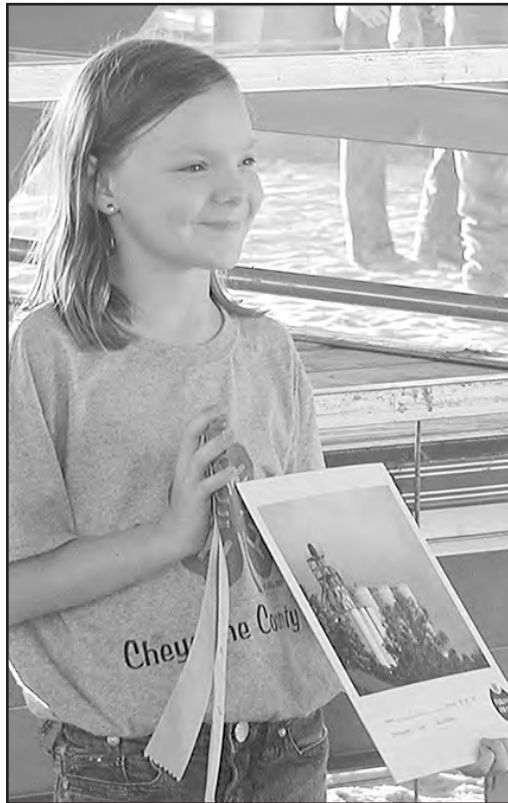
The 4-H/FFA Premium Sale, held Friday during the Cheyenne County Fair, found buyers, individuals and organizations supporting the kids exceptionally well.

When the final dollars were tallied, the sale brought in right at \$86,600 which is almost \$20,000 more than last year.

Paying the highest dollar premium was ABE, St. Francis, paying \$2,700 on Martin Beikman's market steer. Paying the second highest sale premium, \$2,600 on Kyla Bandel's reserve grand champion steer was Yost Ford, St. Francis.

Taylor Roger's premium for his reserve grand champion heifer was \$2,200 and was purchased by Crop Production Service. A \$2,100 premium for Thomas Douthit's purple ribbon steer was also purchased by Crop Production Service. ABE paid \$2,000 for Maraih Beikman's grand champion market hog. The St. Francis Equity paid \$2,000 for Karly Bandel's purple ribbon heifer and Buyer's Group 1 paid \$2,000 for Cutter Neitzel's steer.

The buyers groups have been around for several years. They pool the money so 4-H'ers can get bigger premiums. Those participating in the buyer's groups are listed on Page 2 of this issue along with full details of the sale.

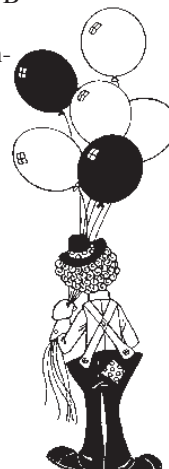

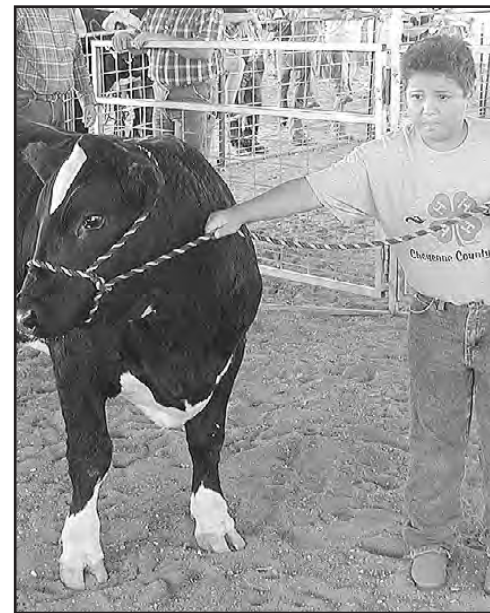

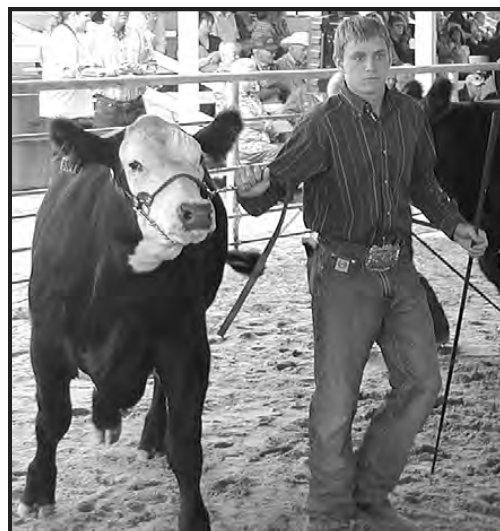

The finals did not disappoint the crowd. A \$50 prize, donated by Mills Ranch was given out to the driver that knocked over a stick placed in the center

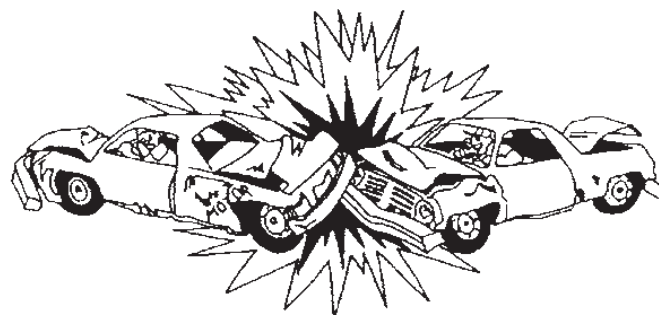
of the arena. That money went to David Rose, who just barely beat out Dennis Vandike.

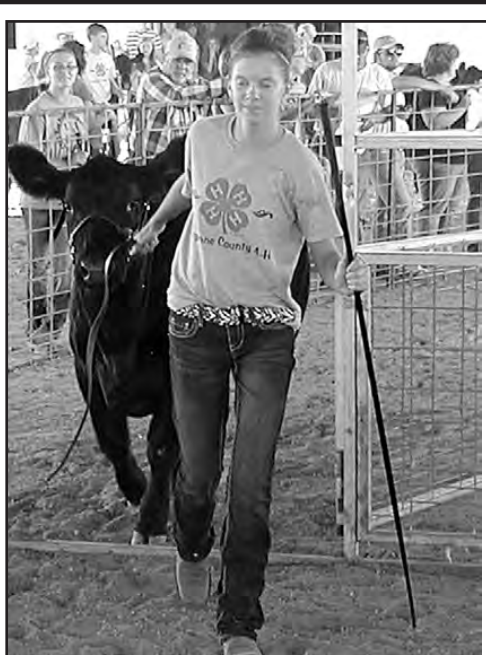

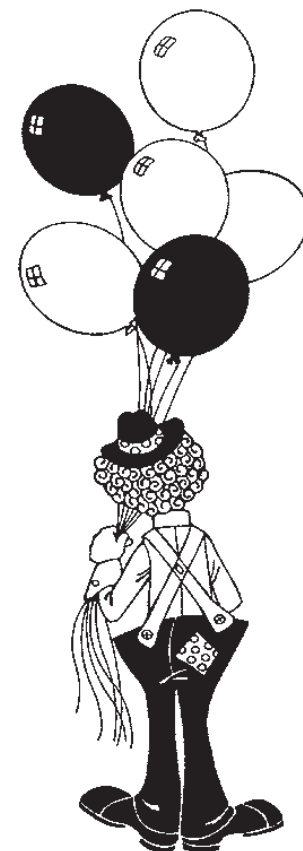
