

Junior high Lady Indians defeated by Hoxie Indians

The St. Francis junior high Lady Indians A and B teams were defeated by the Hoxie Indians on Thursday, Jan 2 in their final regular season game. The Lady Indians will now move on to Northwest Kansas League tournament play beginning week in Hoxie.

The Lady Indians A team moved the ball up steadily in the first quarter to break the Hoxie press. Hoxie had a difficult time dealing with the Indians zone defense. The shots just would not drop for either team. In a low scoring quarter, the Indians led 5-2.

During the second quarter, the Hoxie pressure defense began to take it's toll on the Lady Indians. Hoxie continued to swarm who ever had the ball for St. Francis, causing many errant passes and mistakes by the Lady Indians. Hoxie was beginning to find cracks in the Lady Indians

defense, shooting outside shots and getting layups in the paint. They outscored St. Francis 13 to 7 and took the lead, 15-2 at the half.

In the third quarter, Hoxie took control of the game. Rebekah Castle scored 12 of Hoxie's 14 points and the Lady Indians had no answer, scoring only 6 points as a team. St. Francis fell farther behind, 29-18.

As the fourth quarter progressed, the Lady Indians continued to play hard, but could not make up any ground against Hoxie. The final score, Hoxie 43 St. Francis 28.

Hay harvest permit updated

Hay harvesting on right of way along state and federal highways without a permit is trespassing, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation. Haying permit applications are available at the transportation district and area offices and are valid for one year or a specific haying season.

The department has updated their hay permit form to reflect the following key changes:

The hay permit will expire September 30 annually. Transportation maintenance crews begin mowing out the highway right of way starting on October 1.

No harvesting is to be permitted on the interstate highway right of way.

No equipment shall be left on the right of way longer than 10 days.

The department has dropped the required County Noxious Weed Director signature.

The department reserves the right to retain up to 20% of the bales

harvested from the right of way as part of the permit agreement.

Haying permit applications will be accepted after January 1 for that year's mowing season. Adjacent landowners will be given permit priority until March 31 of a given year. After March 31, permits will be issued in the order they are received.

Permits can be canceled at any time by either party and all operations shall be in accord with requirements and guidelines set by the department. Any person, firm or corporation wanting to mow or bale hay will need to submit a permit application to the office in their area.
