bc.times@nwkansas.com What started out to be a small family dairy in 1914 where all the cows were being milked by hand, has become a dairyman's dream come true for the third and fourth generation McCarty families. In June of 2012 an open house was held for their newly constructed milk processing facility, capable of processing 500,000 pounds of raw milk daily. The family dairy signed a contract with Dannon to become the primary supplier of condensed skim milk for Dan-

This special event all began forming in 1914, when the first generation owners of McCarty Dairy were milking cows by hand in Pennsylvania. In 1999, Tom and Judy bought a wheat farm near Rexford, and sons Mike and Clay joined them in the year 2000 and started milking 750 cows. By 2008, they had increased the herd to 2,000 with 2,350 cows on site.

With a goal of promoting community and economic development for Bird City, Cathy Domsch, executive director of the Century II Development Foundation, created a Dairy Team that visited the Rexford Dairy in 2007 and asked if they would be interested in owning and operating a dairy in Bird City. The timing was right, as, at this time, the McCarty's were seeing a need to expand their present facility.

With the help of a partial loan through Century II's revolv-

working with banks in Texas and northwest Kansas, Kansas Department of Commerce, and United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development/ Midwest Energy, the Bird City Dairy became possible.

Mike McCarty, his wife Amy, and their three children, Colton, Logan and daughter Taylor moved to Bird City, and in 2008, the Bird City McCarty Farms began milking 1800 cows. Today, they are milking 2700, and producing 225,000 pounds of milk

In November of 2011, the Mc-Carty's leased a dairy north of Scott City, and began milking approximately 2000 head. The McCarty's also expanded their farms at Bird City and Rexford, adding capacity to housing calving areas and milking parlors for an additional 1500 cows. 
