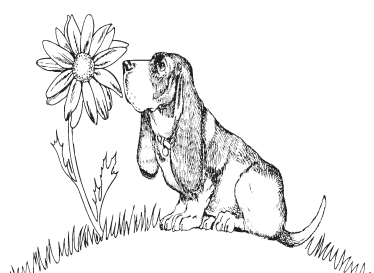
### Garage sale

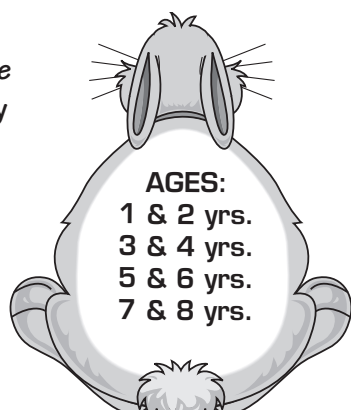
