At 9 a.m., the golf tournament at Riverside will begin. Registration is at 8:30 a.m. The tournament is open to anyone who wants to play.

The annual brat feed will be held starting at noon on Saturday at the museum. This is a great time to check out the museum and enjoy the meal.

in the high school gym from 5 to 6 p.m. The meal in the park will start at 6 p.m. Transportation from the high school to the park and wheel chairs will be available at the park for alumni that need assistance.

It should be noted that the dinner is available to all people who want to come and enjoy the meal as well as visit with classmates and friends. However, you do need to make your reservations by June 6.

New this year will be the beer garden which will be serving from 5 p.m. to midnight on the basketball courts at the park.
