

# Former resident injured

Earl Hanna, 90, a 1941 graduate of St. Francis Community High School, and a passenger, Rhonda Hanna, 79, were both taken to the hospital following a one-vehicle accident Sunday.

According to *The Salina Journal*, the two Colorado residents were taken to the McPherson Memorial Hospital following the accident on Sunday. The Kansas Highway Patrol report stated that Earl Hanna, 90, of Littleton, Colo., was driving a 2011 Toyota eastbound on Kansas Highway 61 at Interstate Highway 70 at 10:40 a.m., when the vehicle exited the roadway, went airborne, struck the ground and then struck Kansas Department of Transportation fencing.

Both Hanna, and passenger, Rhonda Hanna, were taken to the hospital with injuries. Both were wearing seat belts.

# Resolution printed concerning mill levy

### Resolution to Levy Tax for Capital Outlay Fund

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Unified School District No. 297, Cheyenne County, State of Kansas, is authorized by K.S.A. 72-8801, to make an annual tax levy at a mill rate not exceeding the statutorily-prescribed mill rate for a period of time as determined by the Board of Education upon the taxable tangible property in the district for the purpose specified in said law, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has determined to exercise the authority vested in it by said law;

NOW, THEREFORE,

### RESOLUTION

Be it Resolved that:

The above-named school board shall be authorized to make a continuous and permanent annual tax levy in an amount not to exceed 8 mills upon the taxable property in the school district for the purpose of acquisition, construction, reconstruction, repair, remodeling, additions to, furnishing, maintaining and equipping of school district property and equipment necessary for school district purposes, including (1) Acquisition of computer software; (2) acquisition of performance uniforms; (3) housing and boarding pupils enrolled in an area vocational school operated under the board; (4) architectural expenses; (5) acquisition of building sites; (6) undertaking and maintenance of asbestos control projects; (7) acquisition of school buses; and (8) acquisition of other fixed assets, and for the purpose of paying a portion of the principal and interest on bonds issued by cities under the authority of K.S.A. 12-1774, and amendments thereto, for the financing of redevelopment projects upon property located within the school district. The tax levy authorized by this resolution may be made, unless a petition in opposition to the same, signed by not less than 10% of the qualified electors of the school district, is filed with the county election officer of the home county of the school district with 40 calendar days after the last publication of this resolution. In the event a petition is filed, the county election officer shall submit the question of whether the tax levy shall be authorized to the electors in the school district at an election called for that purpose or at the next general election, as is specified by the Board of Education of the above school district
