

Water activity safety tips



- DO learn to swim. If you like to have a good time doing water activities, being a strong swimmer is a must.
- DO take a friend along. Even though you may be a good swimmer, you never know when you may need help. Having friends around is safer and just

What do fishing, water skiing, (watched) areas only, and follow all signs and warnings.

- DO wear a life jacket when boating, jet skiing, water skiing, rafting, or fishing.
- DO keep an eye on the (dark clouds, lighting), pack up and take the fun inside.
- DON'T dive into shallow water. If you don't know how deep the water is, don't dive.
- DON'T float where you can't swim. Keep checking to see if the water is too deep, or if you are too far away from the water bank or the poolside.

you that the water is not clean, because polluted water could • DO know your limits. Watch make you sick. (And even if it is out for the "too's" - too tired, too clean, try not to swallow it.) It's also smart to keep clear of objects in the water like water plants and

for you so, if you see them - go the other way. Finally, if you're outside, you need to guard against the sun. Those burning rays reflect off the water and sand onto you... and they can really spoil the fun! So, rub on some 50 SPF or higher SPF sunscreen to get sun proof.




