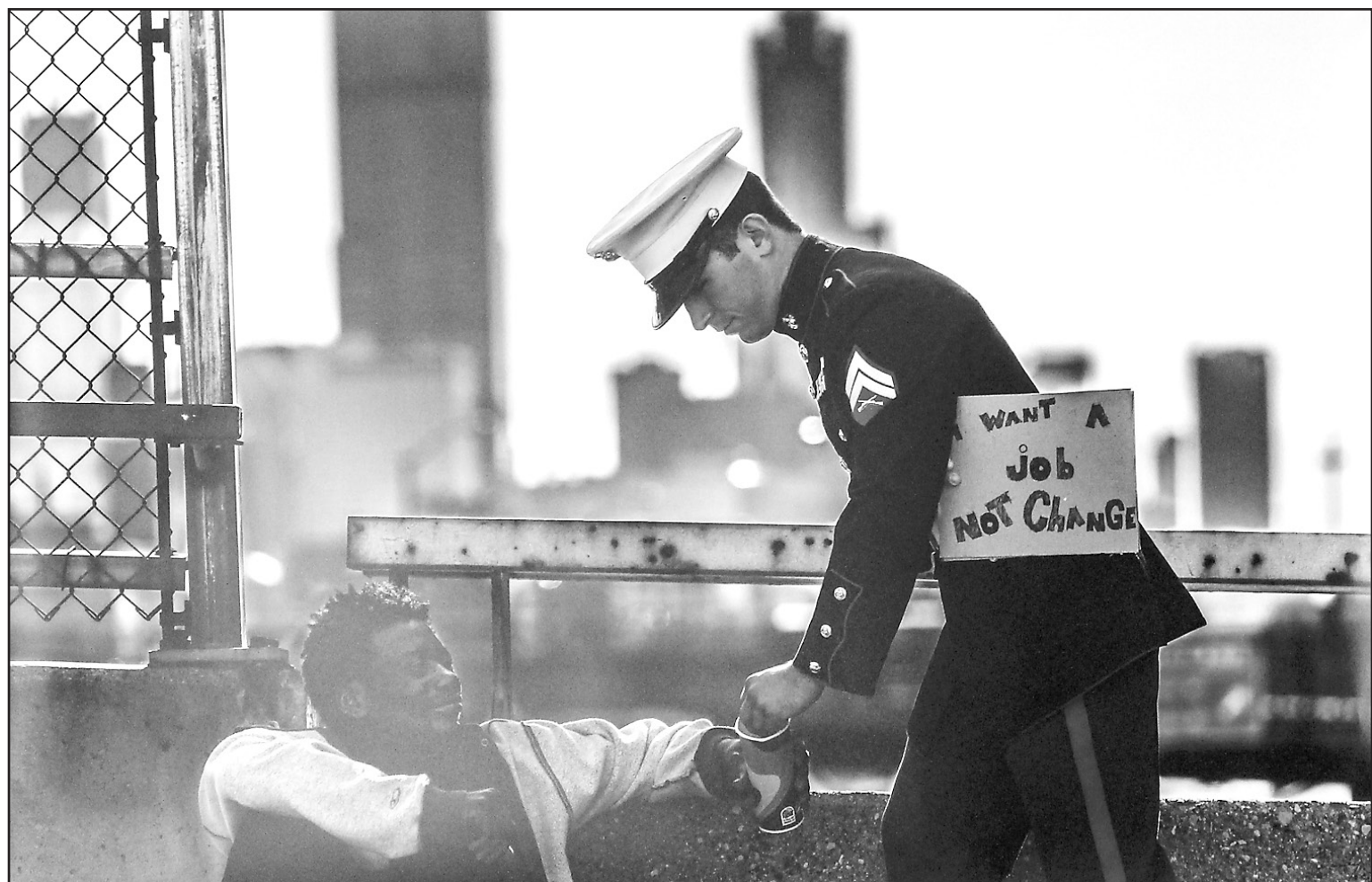
"The mental suffering caused by war is not a passing fad, or something that can be reduced or encapsulated into something our modern mode of thinking or communicating can translate, or even comprehend.

The cyclical anguish spawned by war is the seed that becomes a tree of pain whose branches

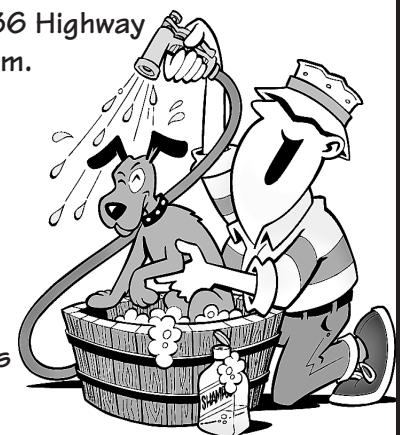
