# Cheylin graduate killed in accident

Nicholas "Nick" Wade Weinstein was killed Feb. 4 while running across a San Diego street. He was a 2000 Cheylin graduate and the son of Terry and Diana Weinstein of Bird City. Nick had just turned 21 on Jan. 24 and was serving as a mess specialist in the U.S. Navy on the submarine U.S.S. Honolulu. His ship, based in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, was docked in San Diego and he and his friend were just going out for supper. The friend saw the vehicle coming and moved out of the way but Nick evidently did not see the vehicle in time. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Nick was born in Benkelman. Besides his parents, he is survived by two sisters, Cassandra Weinstein of St. Francis and Jennifer Weinstein of Bird City; his grandparents Jack and Nancy Weinstein of St. Francis and Harold and Sheryl Behn of Evergreen, Colo.; and his great-grandmother Hope Bressler of Bird City. The funeral service was held on Saturday at the Immanuel United Methodist Church in Bird City. Burial was in the Bird City Cemetery.


