"These scholarships will help students surmount financial barriers to higher education," said Carl Dalstrom,

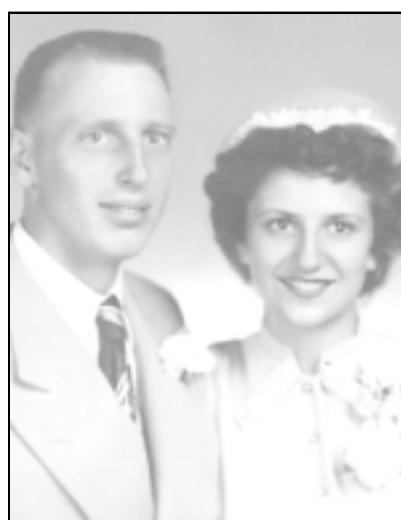
