NOW THERFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Bird City:

quired by state statute; and

Section One. In accordance with state law, the City of Bird City has scheduled a public hearing and has prepared the proposed budget necessary to fund city services from January 1, 2003 until December 31, 2003.

Section Two. After careful public deliberations, the governing body has determined that in order to maintain the public services that are essential for the citizens of this city, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount exceed exceeding the levy in the 2002 budget.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper.


