

Section 1. INCORPORATING UNI-FORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Bird City, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2002, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Bird City, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. AMENDING BIRD CITY CODE. Section 12-102 of the Bird City Code, as adopted by Ordinance No. 270, is hereby amended to read as

12-102 INCORPORATING UNI-FORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Bird City, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2002, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 3. REPEAL. Ordinance No. 288 and all other ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby re-

Section 4. AMENDMENTS. The Uniform Public Offense Code is hereby amended by adding the following sec-

5.3a PURCHASE OR CONSUMP-TION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE BY MINORS; PENALTY.

(a) Except with regard to serving of alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage as permitted by K.S.A. 41-308a, 41-308b,41-2610 and 41-2704, and amendments thereto, no person over 18 but under 21 years of age shall possess, consume, obtain, purchase or attempt to obtain or purchase alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage except as authorized by law. Persons under the age of 18 who shall possess, consume, obtain, purchase or attempt to obtain or purchase alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage except as authorized by law, shall be processed under the Kansas Juvenile Offender

(b) Violation of this section by a person 18 or more years of age but less than 21 years of age is a Class C violation for which the minimum fine is \$200.00

(c) In addition to any other penalty provided for a violation of this section, the court may order the offender to do either or both of the following:

(1) Perform 40 hours of community service; or

(2) Attend and satisfactorily complete a suitable education or training program dealing with the effects of alcohol or other chemical substances when ingested by humans.

(d) This section shall not apply to the possession and consumption of cereal malt beverage by a person under the legal age for consumption of cereal malt beverage when such possession and consumption is permitted and supervised, and such beverage is furnished by the person's parent or legal guardian.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
