ORDINANCE NO. 292
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BIRD CITY, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," EDITION OF 2002, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 287

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BIRD CITY, KANSAS

Section 1. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Bird City, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2002, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, save and except such articles, sections parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive, as amended. No fewer than three copies of said standard ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Bird City, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2: AMENDING BIRD CITY CODE. Section 15-102 of the Bird City Code, as adopted by Ordinance 270, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 15-102. INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Bird City, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2002, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, save and except such articles, sections parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed, such incorporation being authorized by K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive, as amended. No fewer than three copies of said standard ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by the Code of the City of Bird City, Kansas," with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. AMENDING BIRD CITY CODE. Section 12-102 of the Bird City Code, as adopted by Ordinance No. 270, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12-102 INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Bird City, Kansas, that certain code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code," Edition of 2002, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 3. SAME; TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.

(a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. Supp. 8-2118.

(b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions as defined in subsection (a) of this ordinance, shall be considered traffic offenses.

Section 4. PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the municipal judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10 nor more than \$300, except for speeding which shall not be less than \$10 nor more than \$500. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.

SECTION 5 DELETION AND OMISSION. The following section of the above-described Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities is hereby declared to be omitted and deleted, to-wit:

Section 11, relating to specifications of traffic control devices

SECTION 6. AMENDMENTS. The following sections, subsections or parts of sections or subsections, are hereby declared to be amended by replacing the sections or subsections as set forth in said Standard Traffic Ordinance with the language indicated herein, to-wit:

Section 12 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 12. OBEDIENCE TO AND REQUIRED TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES. The driver of any vehicle shall obey the instructions of any traffic control device or sign applicable thereto and placed in a reasonable manner, unless otherwise directed by a police officer, subject to the exceptions granted the driver of an authorized emergency vehicle in this ordinance.

Section 125 is amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 125. DRIVING ACROSS LAWNS, SIDEWALKS, YARDS, CROPS, ETC. It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally drive a motor vehicle upon, across or onto the lawn, sidewalk, yard, farmland, crops, fences or other real or personal property of another person."

SECTION 7. REPEAL. Ordinance No. 287 and all other ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
