BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOV-ERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS KANSAS, that Article 7 of Chapter 15 of the 1994 Code of the City of St. Francis, and entitled INTERNET SERVICE is hereby established to read as follows: ARTICLE 7. INTERNET SERVICE

15-701 ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERNET SERVICE AUTHORIZED. The establishment by the city of the capability of the city to provide internet access service to members of the St. Francis community and its environs is hereby authorized. SERVICE AGREEMENT

AND TERMS OF SERVICE. Prior to the city providing internet service to the Customer, the Customer shall execute and deliver to the city the appropriate Wireless Internet Service Agreement and Terms of Service for St. Francis, Kansas, Wireless Internet Service Agreement. 15-704. BILLING FOR SERVICE.


