ORDINANCE 515
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ARTICLE 7 OF CHAPTER 15 OF THE 1994 CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PROVIDE INTERNET SERVICE TO THE MEMBERS OF THE ST. FRANCIS COMMUNITY AND ITS ENVIRONS AS A UTILITY SERVICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS KANSAS, that Article 7 of Chapter 15 of the 1994 Code of the City of St. Francis, and entitled INTERNET SERVICE is hereby established to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7. INTERNET SERVICE
15-701 ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERNET SERVICE AUTHORIZED. The establishment by the city of the capability of the city to provide internet access service to members of the St. Francis community and its environs is hereby authorized. The city personnel, under the direction of the city superintendent, and after approval by the city council, are authorized and directed to secure the necessary bandwidth access, computer hardware and software.

15-702 PROVIDING OF SERVICE. Upon application to the city by interested members of the community, including persons, city sub-divisions, the United States of America, the State of Kansas, and its political sub-divisions (Customer) for internet access service and after a determination has been made by city personnel that service can be delivered to the site requested, the service will be provided by the city to the Customer as per the terms and conditions of a Wireless Internet Service Agreement and Terms of Service for St. Francis, Kansas, Wireless Internet Service Agreement.

15-703. SERVICE AGREEMENT AND TERMS OF SERVICE. Prior to the city providing internet service to the Customer, the Customer shall execute and deliver to the city the appropriate Wireless Internet Service Agreement and Terms of Service for St. Francis, Kansas, Wireless Internet Service Agreement.

15-704. BILLING FOR SERVICE. The monthly service charges to the customer for the internet access service shall be billed along with the Customer's regular utility billing. Customers who are not city utility users shall be billed separately.

15-705. INTERNET SERVICE FUND. The city clerk is directed to establish, as of January 1, 2003, and maintain a separate utility fund designated as the Internet Service Fund to record and track all expenditures and receipts generated as a result of the city's providing of this service.

This Article 7 of Chapter 15 shall take effect and be enforced from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, the **St. Francis Herald**.
