Washburn University

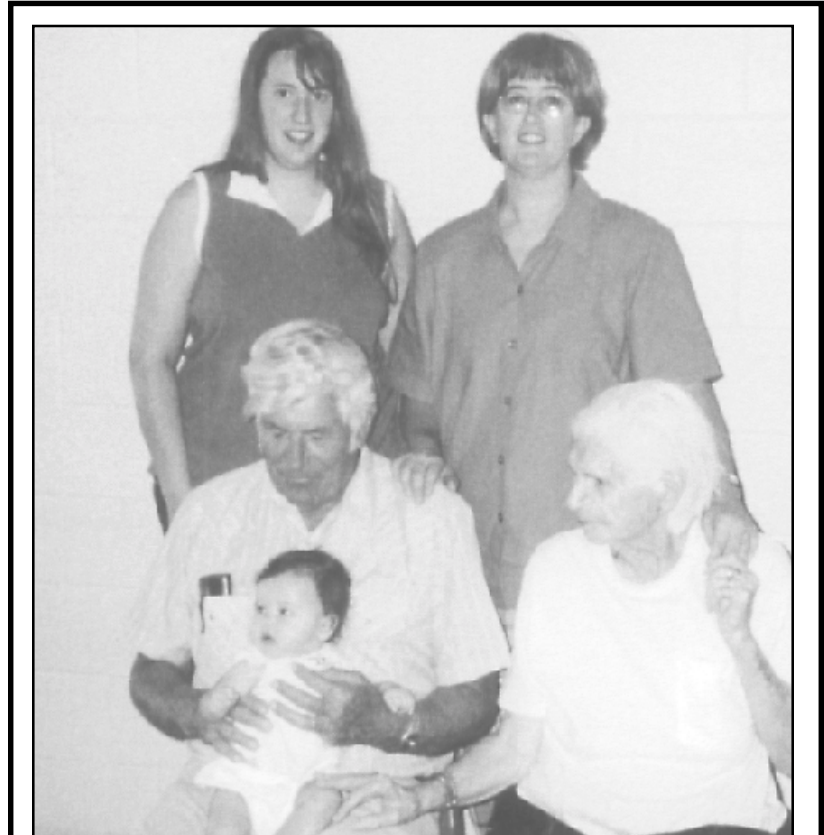

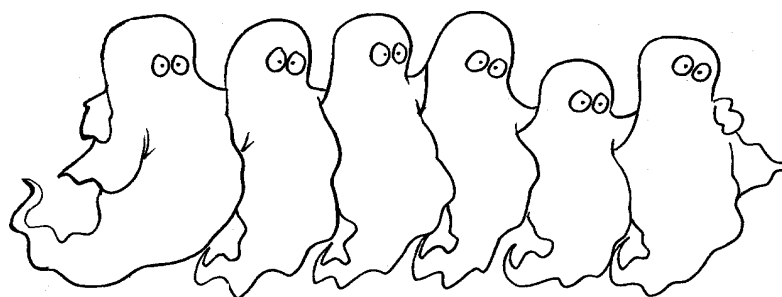
Mr. and Mrs. Jack Lampe

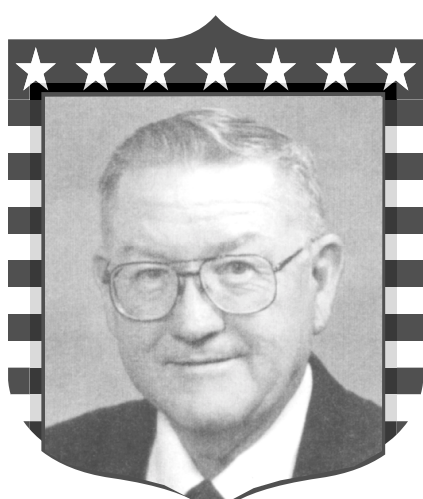
