

Five wrestlers earn trip to State tourney

Hoxie and Norton fought for the title at the Norton 3-2-1A Regional wrestling tournament on Friday and Saturday with Hoxie the victor with 193 points compared to 187.5 for Norton.

"It was a good tournament," Coach Larry Gabel said. "Norton and Hoxie dominated the action and each will be taking 10 wrestlers to State."

St. Francis placing third in a close finish over Oakley (118-117). Five St. Francis wrestlers qualified for State competition by placing in the top four positions in their weight class.
