

# St. Francis hosts **Invitational**

The St. Francis girls 4x800-meter relay team set a new school record Tuesday, April 27, at the 37th annual St. Francis High School Invitational track meet. Megan Rice, Amy Grace, Lauren Ross and McKenzie Grace combined for a time of 10:31.77 to earn the new school mark.

Seventeen boys teams competed with Oakley earning first place with 122 points. This was a repeat for Oakley, who also placed first last year. St. Francis placed fifth on Tuesday with 50 points.

Leading the way for the Sainty boys was Derek Ross with a first place finish in the pole vault with a

In the girls division, Colby placed first out of 18 teams with 97 points. Hoxie placed second with 91 and the St. Francis Lady Indians came in third with 66 points. Colby replaced Hoxie who was the 2003 winner.

The 4x800-meter relay team was 1.5 the only first place winner for St. Francis although a number of individuals placed.

Scoring was 10-8-6-4-2-1 for the first six finishes. First and second place team plaques were awarded and medals through five places in all individual events and relays.

The sun was out on Tuesday and a large group of parents and other fans arrived from participating towns to cheer on the athletes.
