Producers reminded of Sept. 1 deadline for noninsured crops

Bill R. Fuller, state director for the Kansas Farm Service Agency reminds producers that Sept. 1 is the application closing date for certain crops under the Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance program.

Sept. 1 is the final date to pay the applicable service fee and obtain Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program coverage for small grain crops, aquaculture, canola, Christmas trees, nursery crops, speltz, and turf grass sod.

Dear Plain Sense: My 4-year-old frequently steals things from other family members. I'm worried he is on his way to becoming a petty thief! What should I do?

Parents naturally become concerned about a child who takes things that don't belong to them. This should not be regarded as "stealing" until the child is capable of understanding the consequences of such behavior, which is usually between ages 3 to 5 years old.

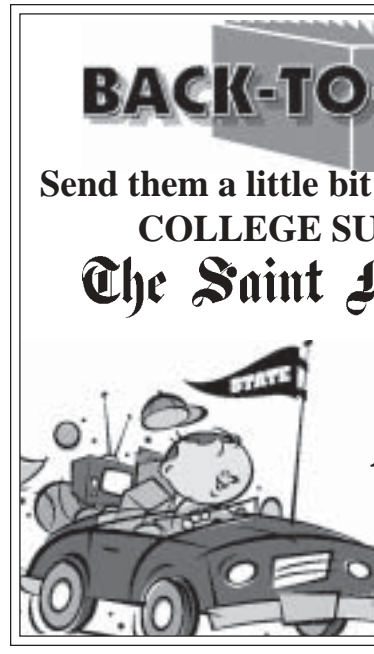

calendar days after the disaster occurrence, or the date the loss becomes apparent to the producer. Producers are limited to \$100,000 in benefits per person per crop year, they must certify crop acres by applicable deadlines, maintain production evidence for three years, not exceed the \$2 million gross revenue provisions, and must comply with conservation compliance provisions in order to be eligible.

Interested producers shall contact their local Farm Service Agency prior to the Sept. 1 application closing date to obtain Noninsured Crop Disaster Assistance Program coverage.

If stealing is persistent or accompanied by other problem behaviors, it may be a sign of more serious emotional problems that both child and parents need help with. Distrust can develop quickly in such family situations.

Parents should teach children about property rights and consideration of others. Parents must also serve as positive role models. If adults bring home items from their place of work, or allow a mistake at the supermarket check-out to occur in their favor, it will be harder for a child to understand the concept of honesty.
