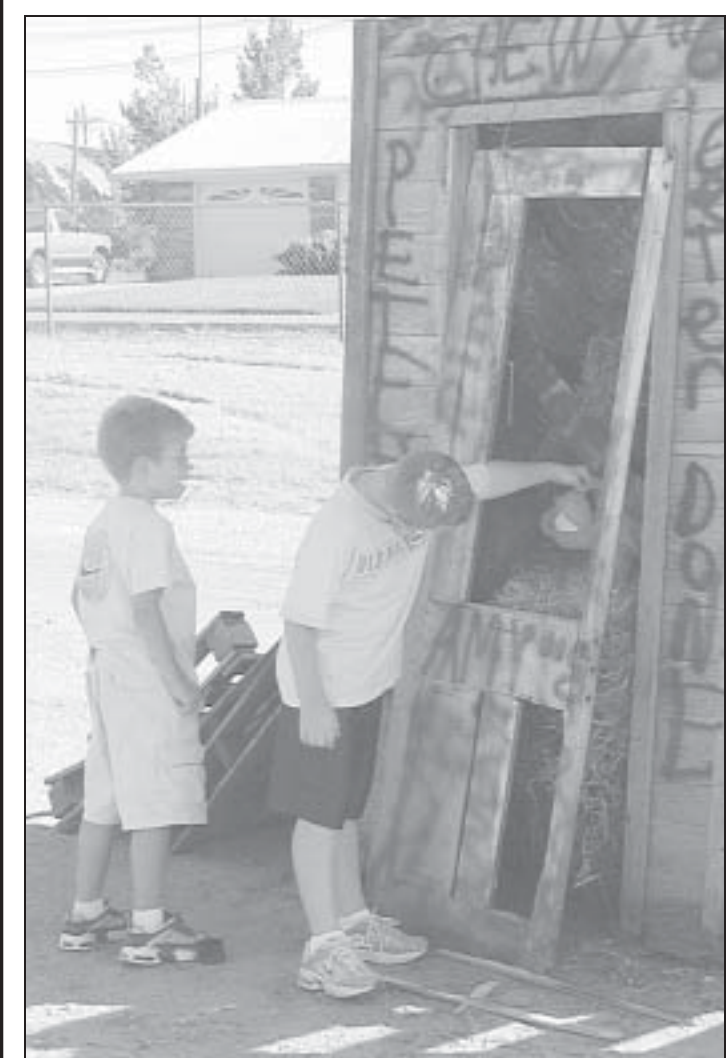

Local boys to compete at livestock show

Trevor Reed and Darin Wiley of Cheyenne County are among the youth from 88 Kansas counties who will be competing at the 72nd annual Kansas Junior Livestock Show in Wichita. The Sept. 24 through Sept. 27 event will feature 717 contestants exhibiting 1,485 head of livestock. Participants have entered 42 steers, 283 heifers, 422 market hogs, 336 lambs, 73 breeding ewes and 229 wether dams. Total exhibitors and livestock numbers for the show are slightly larger than last year.

to the auction. Separate from the selection of specie champions, a showmanship contest will be held. Exhibitors of cattle, sheep and swine are eligible to compete in the invitational showmanship contest, sponsored by the Kansas Junior Livestock Association. The top showman in both the junior and senior divisions will receive a silver belt buckle. Prizes also will be awarded for second through fifth place in each division.

The top five animals from each of the market divisions - steers, hogs and lambs, will sell during the Kansas Junior Livestock Show Auction of Champions at 7 p.m., Sept. 27. In many cases, exhibitors of the in-coming livestock use money earned from the premium auction to help fund their college education and buy next year's livestock project.

The Kansas Junior Livestock Association Club Calf Show and Sale will be held in conjunction with the Kansas Junior Livestock Show. More than 60 head of prospect steers and heifers will sell at 7 p.m. Sept. 25 with a portion of the sale proceeds going to scholarships and educational activities.

The show is sponsored by the Kansas Livestock Association, Kansas State University and the Wichita Area Chamber of Commerce, plus hundreds of volunteers.
