

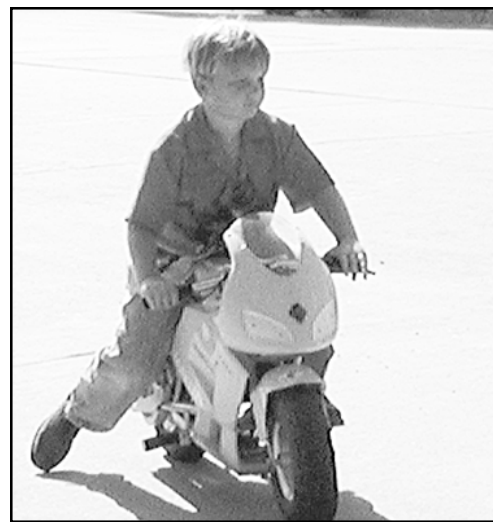

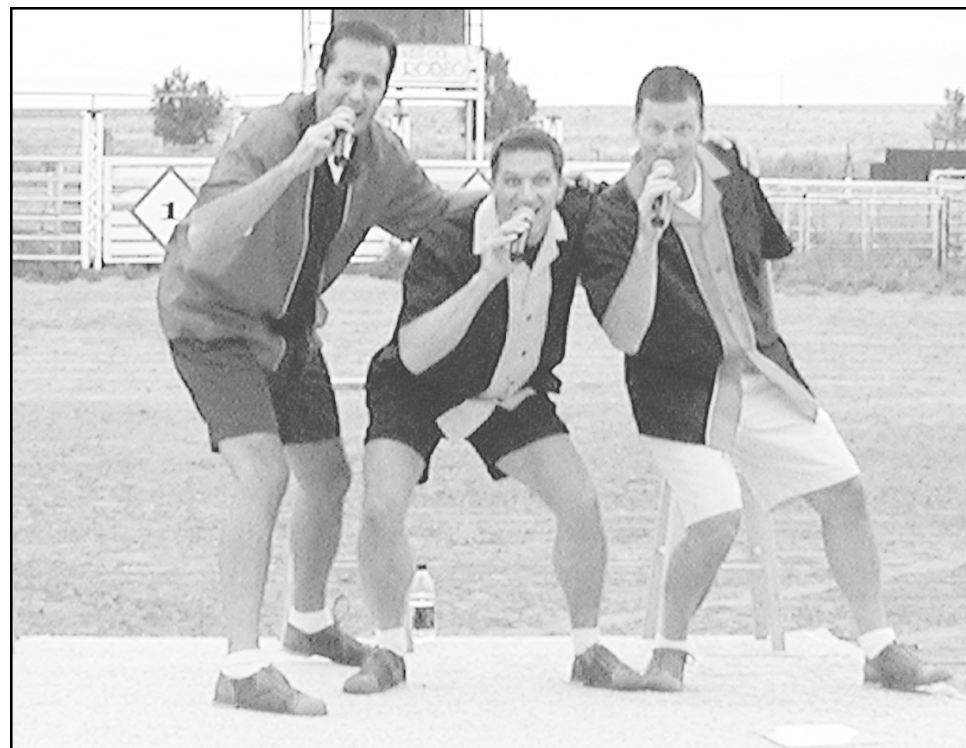
St. Francis Community High School cheerleaders entertained those lining the street for the parade.



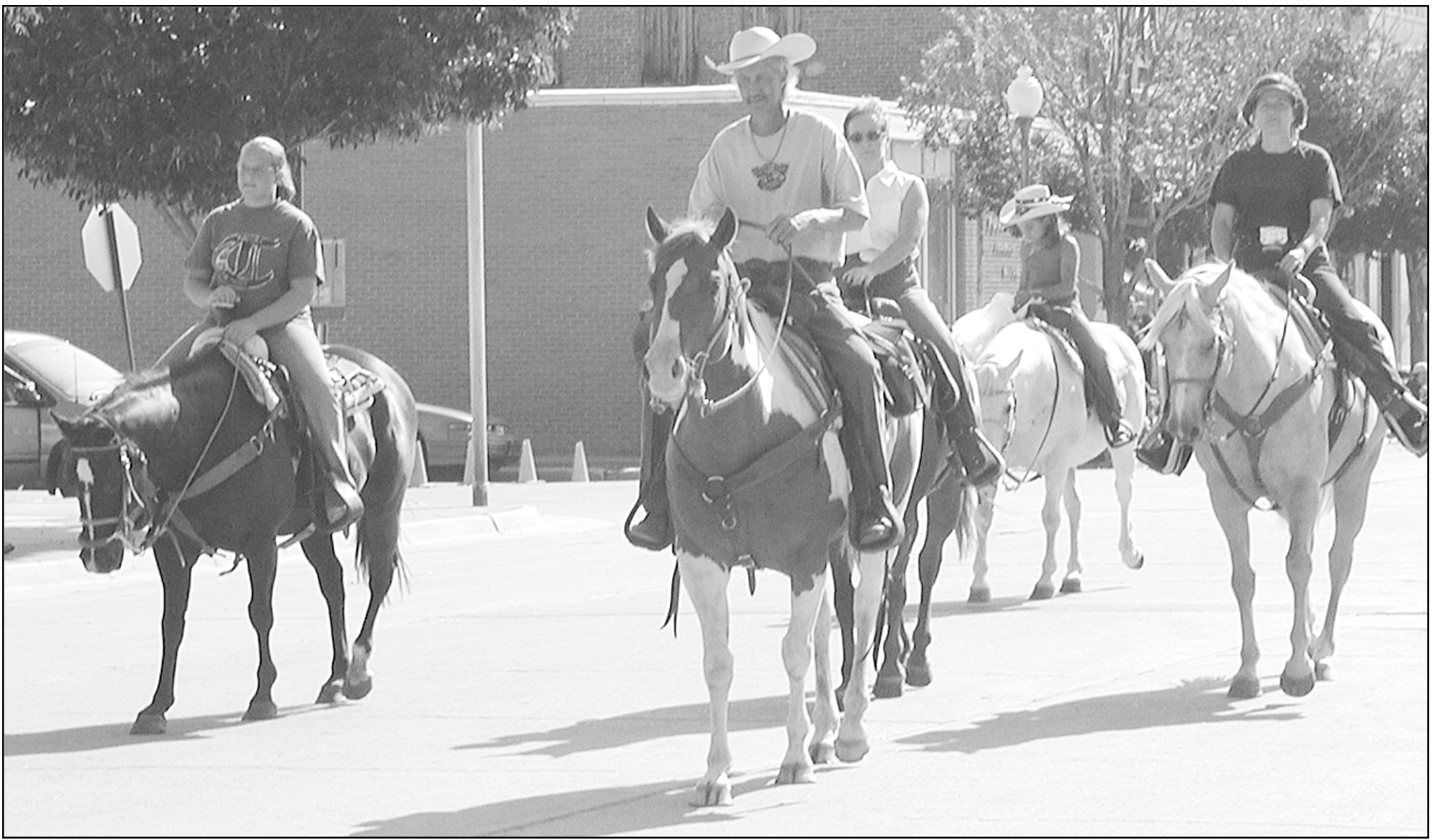
The Windmill Restaurant float provided bottle water to the crowds. Nikki Tafoya carried Jasper Hunt throughout the long walk.



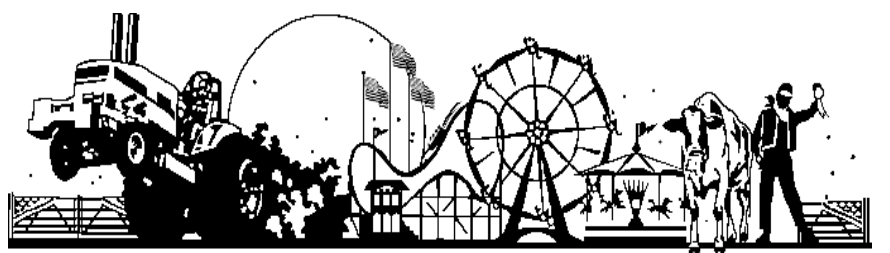
This unidentified young man was on one of the smaller motorcycles at the parade. Below, Streetside singers entertained the audience in front of the grandstand on Thursday night of the fair.
