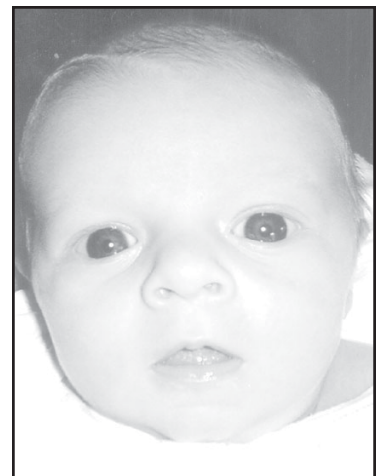
Flag Football
