CHEYENNE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

The Cheyenne County Sheriff's Office has been advised that two head of stray cattle have been recovered in the St. Francis area. One is described as a yearling Red Angus mix heifer with no readable brand. The other is described as an Angus or Angus cross bull 4-5 years old with a "W" over a mill iron brand on the left rib and an "I" over "J" brand on the left hip. Anyone wishing to claim these cattle needs to contact the Cheyenne County Sheriff's Office at (785) 332-3330. If they are not claimed by January 4th, 2006, they will be sold at auction on that date.

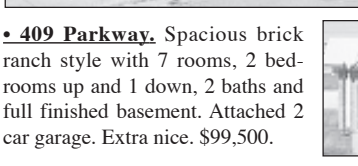
