NOTICE TO THOMAS COUNTY TAXPAYERS

It is your responsibilities to file your Personal Property Assessment with the County Appraiser's Office each year. Reportable items include: Farm Trucks, Trailers, Mopeds, Dirt Bikes, ATV's, Camping Trailers, Boats, Airplanes, Mobile Homes, Golf Carts, Jet Skis, Snowmobiles, and Business Equipment & Fixtures. Real Estate improvements, or structural changes to buildings must also be reported. The filing deadline is the same for Individuals, Businesses, and Corporations. Due date is on or before March, 15 2011. The deadline will be observed and penalties imposed as directed by law. We don't like imposing penalties any more than you like paying them. PLEASE FILE EARLY. If you have previously had property to declare, the forms were mailed in January. Otherwise, assistance will be provided at the Appraiser's Office in the basement of the Courthouse in Colby from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.
