

CLAFLIN (AP) — If the 600 or so single voice about their hometown hero Jackie Stiles, it might sound something like this:

We told you so.

People in the tiny central Kansas town say they've known all along that led Southwest Missouri State to the women's Final Four—was something special. Now, the country knows.

In what has become a typical performance, Stiles — the all-time NCAA women's scoring leader — had 32 points in Monday's 104-87 win over Washington.
