

### ORDINANCE NO. 1310

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY, IN BLOCK SEVENTY-FOUR (74), WEST ADDITION TO THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Colby, Kansas, deems it necessary and expedient to vacate and discontinue the alley in Block Seventy-four (74), West Addition to the City of Colby, Kansas, running North and South as shown by the recorded plat, thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Kansas State Statute 14-423, the Governing Body of said City of Colby, Kansas, has such power and authority.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLBY, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the alley in Block Seventy-four (74), running North and South, West Addition to the City of Colby, Kansas, as shown by the recorded plat thereof, is hereby vacated.

**SECTION 2.** That said vacated alley shall revert to the owner of real estate thereto adjacent on each side as provided by law.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage and publication in the official City paper unless one or more interested parties file a written protest before the expiration of such time as provided by law.
