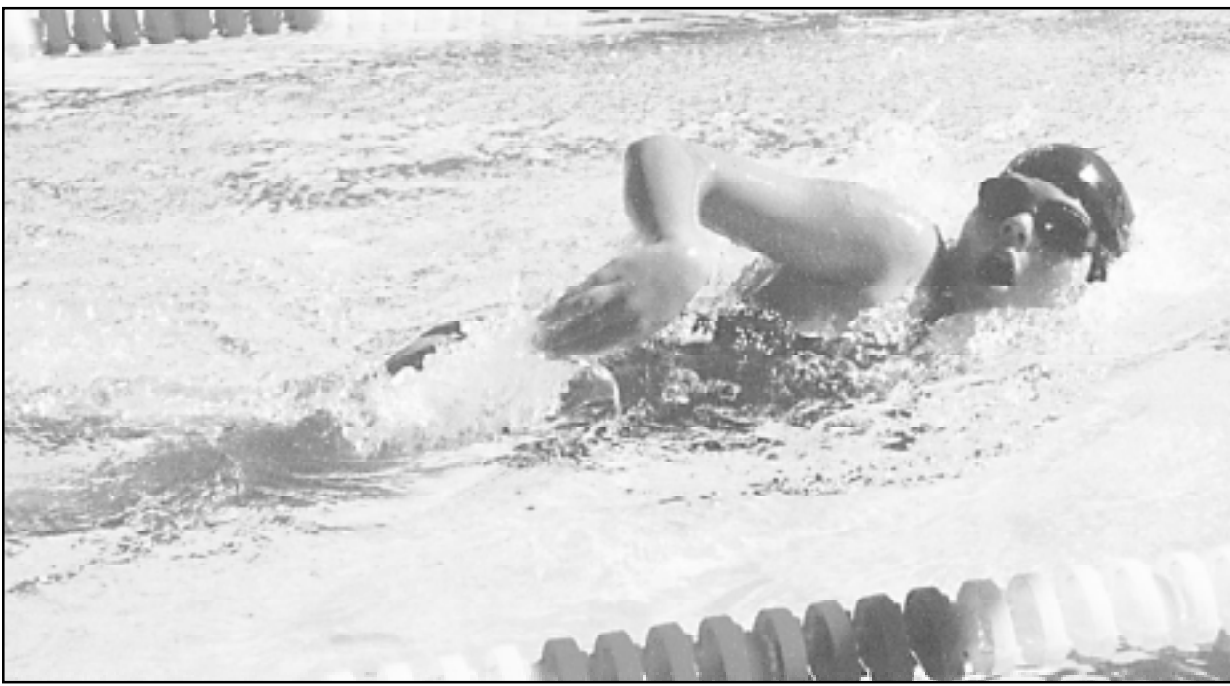

Fay is guard at Cody-Kilgore High School in Cody, Neb. As a junior, he averaged 20 points per game with 7.2 boards.

He had 89 assists and 64 steals on the year, with a 71 percent free-throw average and 43 percent from the field.

Kilgore was 17-5 and lost in the second round of sub-district play.

They averaged 59.1 points per game and allowed only 45.5.

"This will give him a chance to experience national competition in an intense competitive atmosphere," said Greenlee.

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — The Los Angeles Lakers moved within one victory of repeating as champions.

Shaquille O'Neal had 34 points and 14 rebounds and Kobe Bryant came within one assist of a triple-double as the Lakers defeated the Philadelphia 76ers 100-86 in Game 4 of the NBA Finals.

If they can close out the series Friday night in Game 5, the Lakers will finish with the best postseason run in NBA history — 15-1. They already have the 76ers in dire straits, as no team has ever come back from a 3-1 deficit in the finals.

Bryant finished with 19 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists.

Iverson left the game with a minute-and-a-half left after scoring 35 points.
