

After Hampton homered in the eighth inning off Miguel Batista, Arizona tied the score in the bottom half on an RBI double by Mark Grace, who also hit a two-run double in the first

Hampton, who has four homers in his last 12 at-bats, is the first pitcher to home runs.

PHOENIX (AP) — Mike Hampton hit six in one season since 1971, when Rick Wise did it.

> Hampton is three shy of the record for pitchers, set by Cleveland's Wes Ferrell in 1931.

> Hampton, who had never homered before this season, has four at homer-friendly Coors Field and also connected at Florida.

Hampton is hitting 14-for-45 (.311) with 11 RBIs and his season home-run total is only one shy of Mark McGwire's.

He allowed four runs and 10 hits in eight innings.

Colorado has lost three straight and 11 of its last 13.
