

Colby swimmers are second in Wray meet

The Colby Swim Club took second at the Wray, Colo. meet on Saturday.

The Colby boys led their division at 114.5 points, only one point ahead of Burlington, Colo.

Finishing the mascots

We have been looking at Big 12 mascots, and are ready to finish with our Texas teams.

Texas Tech's Red Raider first appeared in 1954, leading the football team into the stadium on a jet black quarterhorse. The masked rider, wearing black riding clothes, a mask, a bolero hat and a scarlet cape, the tradition continues. One little known fact is that the masked rider is usually a woman. Tech historians say there is no rule or tradition, but women usually get the job.

Reveille, Texas A & M's full-bred American Collie came from a 1931 incident in which some cadets accidentally ran over a dog in their Model T and brought the dog back to the dorm. In the morning, the dog began barking as soon as the bugler sounded reveille, earning a name and mascot status. Reveille VII is the highest ranking officer in the Corps of Cadets and lives with the members of Company E-2.

The winning entry in Baylor's 1914 mascot contest was a bear. The first live bear was donated by the 107th Engineers, a unit of the 32nd Division stationed at Camp MacArthur during World War I. The bear, named Ted, made his first appearance at the 1917 game against Texas A & M.

Bevo may be the most famous of the Texas mascots. The orange and white mascot for the longhorns actually came about when a Texas graduate named Steve Pinckey, also a football manager, found the original Bevo along the Mexican border while fighting rustlers. He paid for the steer with the alumni association's subscription dues. Bevo made his first home debut against Texas Tech in 1916.

There you have it, the origins of the Big 12 mascots.
