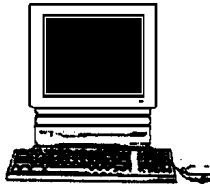
**Tennis practice to start Monday**

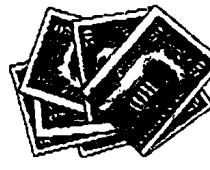

## Cards pitcher gets one-hitter

MONTREAL (AP) — Darryl Kile was aware he hadn't allowed a hit, but he wasn't trying for a no-hitter.

Kile settled for a four-hitter for his 28th career complete game, and Albert Pujols and Jim Edmonds homered as the St. Louis Cardinals beat the Montreal Expos 3-1 Tuesday night.

Kile (12-7) didn't allow a hit until pitcher Javier Vazquez doubled with

one out in the sixth inning.

"As soon as you think about something like that, you get tonged for a couple of runs," Kile said.

"That's not so much of an important thing right now."

Jose Vidro added an RBI single that inning for Montreal's only run.

Pujols hit his 27th homer with one out in the second off Vazquez (10-11).

The Cardinals scored an unearned run in the third and Edmonds hit his 15th homer leading off the fourth to go up 3-0.

"Vazquez is a great pitcher," Edmonds said. "We were lucky we got three runs off him."

"And Darryl Kile, the way he pitched, that was a tough game to be a hitter."
