WHEREAS, the 2000 Kansas Legislature significantly reduced demand transfer payments to local governments below last year's levels.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Colby, Kansas:

Section 1. In accordance with state law the City of Colby has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund city services from January 1, 2002 until December 31, 2002.

Section 2. After careful public deliberations, the Governing Body has determined that in order to maintain the public services which are essential for the citizens of this City, it will be necessary to budget property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds the 2001 budget

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect after publication once in the official city newspaper
