### COLBY CEMETERY DISTRICT #1 RESOLUTION 2001 -1

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE PROPERTY TAXATION POLICY OF THE BOARD OF COLBY CEMETERY DISTRICT #1 WITH RESPECT TO FINANCING THE 2002 ANNUAL BUDGET FORTHOMAS COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 79-2925b provides that a resolution be adopted if property taxes levied to finance the 2002 Colby Cemetery District #1 budget exceed the amount levied to finance the 2001 Colby Cemetery District #1 budget, except with regard to revenue produced and attributable to the taxation of 1) new improvements to real property, 2) increased personal property valuation, other than increased valuation of oil and gas leaseholds and mobile homes, and 3) property which has changed in use during the past year, or with regard to revenue produced for the purpose of repaying the principal of and interest upon bonded indebtedness, temporary notes, or no-fund warrants, and

WHEREAS, budgeting, taxing and service level decisions for all county services are the responsibility of the Board of the Cemetery District #1 and,

WHEREAS, The Cemetery Board provides the essential services to protect the health and safety, and well being of the citizens of the District, and

WHEREAS, the cost of provision of these services continues to increase, and

WHEREAS, the 2001 Kansas State Legislature failed to fulfill its obligations in regard to the statutory funding of demand transfers and, by significantly reducing state revenue sharing payments to counties, has contributed to higher county property tax levies to finance the 2001 THOMAS County budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of The Colby Cemetery District #1 that it is our desire to notify the public of the possibility of increased property taxes to finance the 2002 Colby Cemetery District #1 budget due to the above mentioned constraints, and that all persons are invited and encouraged to attend budget meeting conducted by the Board of Colby Cemetery District #1. The date and time of budget hearings with the Board of Colby Cemetery District #1 will be published in the COLBY FREE PRESS. Interested persons can also address questions concerning the budget to the officer of Colby Cemetery District #1.

WHEREAS, the Thomas County KS is a "participating employer" as defined by K.S.A. 74-4902(24).




Be it still further resolved, that the governing board of Thomas County recommends to its citizens to support relief efforts by giving blood at the nearest available blood donation center.

AVOID ABBREVIATIONS - Abbreviations will make your ad look like a secret code message. Rather than trying to figure out what you have to say, confused readers will just go on to the next ad. INCLUDE PRICE - Price is one of the biggest concerns of classified shoppers. Ads that list prices will get their first attention. Including price also helps you avoid inquiries from callers not in your price range. BE AVAILABLE - List your telephone number or address so potential buyers will know HOW to contact you. State the best hours to call. If you are not home when an interested prospect calls, chances are he won't call back. FEEL FREE TO ASK FOR HELP - because help is FREE for the asking. The Free Press staff will be happy to help you word your ad.
