WASHINGTON (AP) — The government has banned all aircraft from flying within 3 miles of major professional and college sporting events and any other large open air gathering.

The Federal Aviation Administration's "no-fly zone" will extend up to an altitude of 3,000 feet.

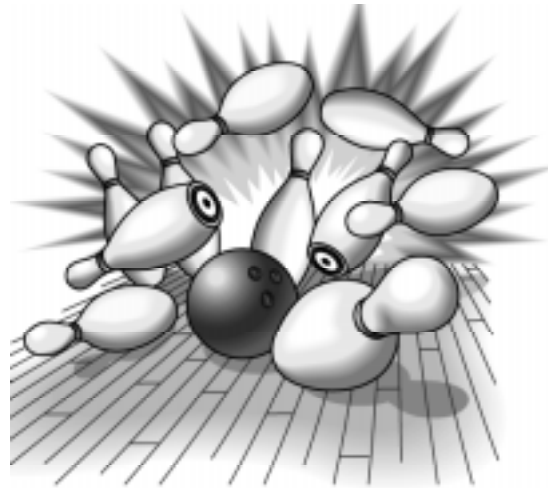
