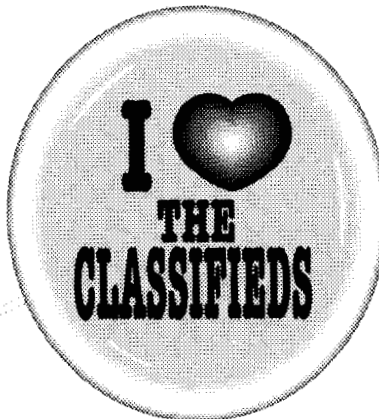

ORDINANCE NO. 2001-02

An ordinance vacating certain parts of the street between blocks eleven, twelve (11, 12) and five, six (5, 6) in Original Town Addition to the town of Gem, Thomas County, Kansas, as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the City of Gem, Kansas:

Section 1. The following described street are hereby vacated:

That part of Sheridan Street between blocks eleven, twelve, (11, 12) and five, six (5, 6), Original Town Addition to the town of Gem, Thomas County, Kansas, as shown by the recorded plat thereof.

Section 2. The street herein vacated shall revert to the owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to the frontage of such real estate as provided by Kansas law.

Section 3. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing shall be held on the 15th of November at 7:00 P.M. in the Gem Community Building, at which time the Council may approve or disapprove the ordinance for vacating of said street.

Section 4. Immediately when this ordinance becomes effective, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of the ordinance in the office of the Register of Deeds.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval and publication in the official paper.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Thomas County, Kansas, has previously adopted the Thomas County Environmental/Sanitary Code, Resolution No. 1992-13 effective date of June 1, 1993, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt fees for Code rendered services for the purposes funding the authorized Representative (Northwest Local Environmental Protection Group) for the administration and enforcement of the Thomas County Environmental/Sanitary Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Thomas County, Kansas that the fees listed within the revised Administrative Procedures for Chapter 2 of the above stated Code are hereby adopted and said fees shall be collected by the Northwest Local Environmental Protection Group to provide funding for the purposes of administering and enforcing the Thomas County Environmental/Sanitary Code previously adopted by the Board of County Commissioners, Resolution No 1992-13.

THIS RESOLUTION shall take effect March 1, 2002.

BE COMPLETE - Put yourself in the reader's place. If you were considering buying this item, what would you want to know about it? Give the item's age, condition, size, brand name and any other information needed to describe it accurately and completely.

DON'T EXAGGERATE - Misleading information may bring potential buyers to your home, but it won't help you make the sale once they've arrived.

AVOID ABBREVIATIONS - Abbreviations will make your ad look like a secret code message. Rather than trying to figure out what you have to say, confused readers will just go on to the next ad.

INCLUDE PRICE - Price is one of the biggest concerns of classified shoppers. Ads that list prices will get their first attention. Including price also helps you avoid inquiries from callers not in your price range.

BE AVAILABLE - List your telephone number or address so potential buyers will know HOW to contact you. State the best hours to call. If you are not home when an interested prospect calls, chances are he won't call back.

FEEL FREE TO ASK FOR HELP - because help is FREE for the asking. The Free Press staff will be happy to help you word your ad.
