Franklin Colby, Kansas, at 9:30 A.M. on Thursday, November 29, 2001, to hear a request for a zoning change from Curtis G. Stephens and Jacqueline Stephens, owners, from S-1 (Suburban) to L-1 (Industrial), more particularly described as follows:

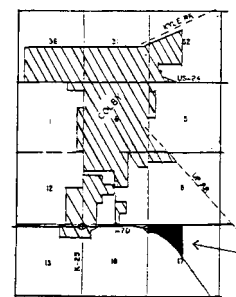
A tract of land located in the SW1/4 of Section 8 and the NW1/4 of Section 17, Township 8 South, Range 33 West of the 6th Principal Meridian in Thomas County, Kansas, more particularly described as follows:
