

Ladies get 20-point win against Wray

The Colby High School Lady Eagle basketball team improved their record to 4-2 with a 65-45 win on the road against Wray, Colo. Tuesday.

Colby jumped out to a 15-4 lead midway through the second period, only to have Wray pull to within just two points at half-time.

In the third quarter, Colby began to stretch their lead, but again Wray battled back, cutting into Colony's lead and trailing 42-35 at the start of the final period.

The Lady Eagles turned up the pressure on the defensive end of the court and outscored Wray 23-10 in the final stanza to claim their third straight win.

All five of the Lady Eagles' starters scored in double figures, giving the team a very balanced attack.

Ivy Ramsey led Colby in scoring with 19 points. She also grabbed four rebounds and four steals, dished out three assists and rejected one shot.

Summar Stephens followed with 15 points, a team-high nine boards, six

steals and one assist. Amanda Seemann knocked down 11 points, recorded three rebounds and stole the ball six times.

Brianna Swafford and Bethanie Linden both finished with 10 points. Linden was credited with seven rebounds and two steals, while Swafford had one board, three steals and two assists.

Breann Hart, Samantha Wolf and Emily Sloan all contributed to the cause. Hart recorded one rebound, one steal and one assist, with Wolf adding one board and one steal, while Sloan grabbed one rebound and one blocked shot.

Colby made only 32 percent of their shots, including 2-for-7 from beyond the arc, but improved at the free-throw line, connecting on 17-of-27 for 63 percent.

The next action will be against Colony's arch-rival Goodland Cowgirls at Max Jones Fieldhouse in

Goodland on Jan. 4. Varsity games start at 6 p.m.

Colby jayvee 60, Wray 39

In the jayvee game, Colby came out on top 60-39, improving their record to 2-3. The Eagles held a one point lead at the end of the first period, but extended their lead to 24-16 at the half.

Marcia Kaus scored a team-high 12 points and was also credited with seven rebounds and two steals.

Shawna Cox and Jennifer Hutfles contributed nine points each. Hutfles recorded five boards and three steals, while Cox had two rebound and a blocked shot.

Desiree Sharp finished the game with eight points, including 4-for-4 from the free-throw line. She also grabbed two rebounds and three steals.

Crystal Mannebach was perfect from the charity stripe, connecting on four shots. Mannebach scored six points, pulled down rebounds and had

two steals and one assist. Samantha Wolf and Breann Hart both had six points, with Wolf getting credit for a steal and an assist and Hart had one rebound and two take-aways.

Rounding out the scoring was Tasha Fromholtz with four points. Layla Woodall grabbed two rebounds in the game.

The jayvee team shot an impressive 76 percent from the free-throw line at 16-for-21 and connected on 2-for-3 shots behind the 3-point line.

In C-team action, Colby fell to the Wray Eagles 36-32.

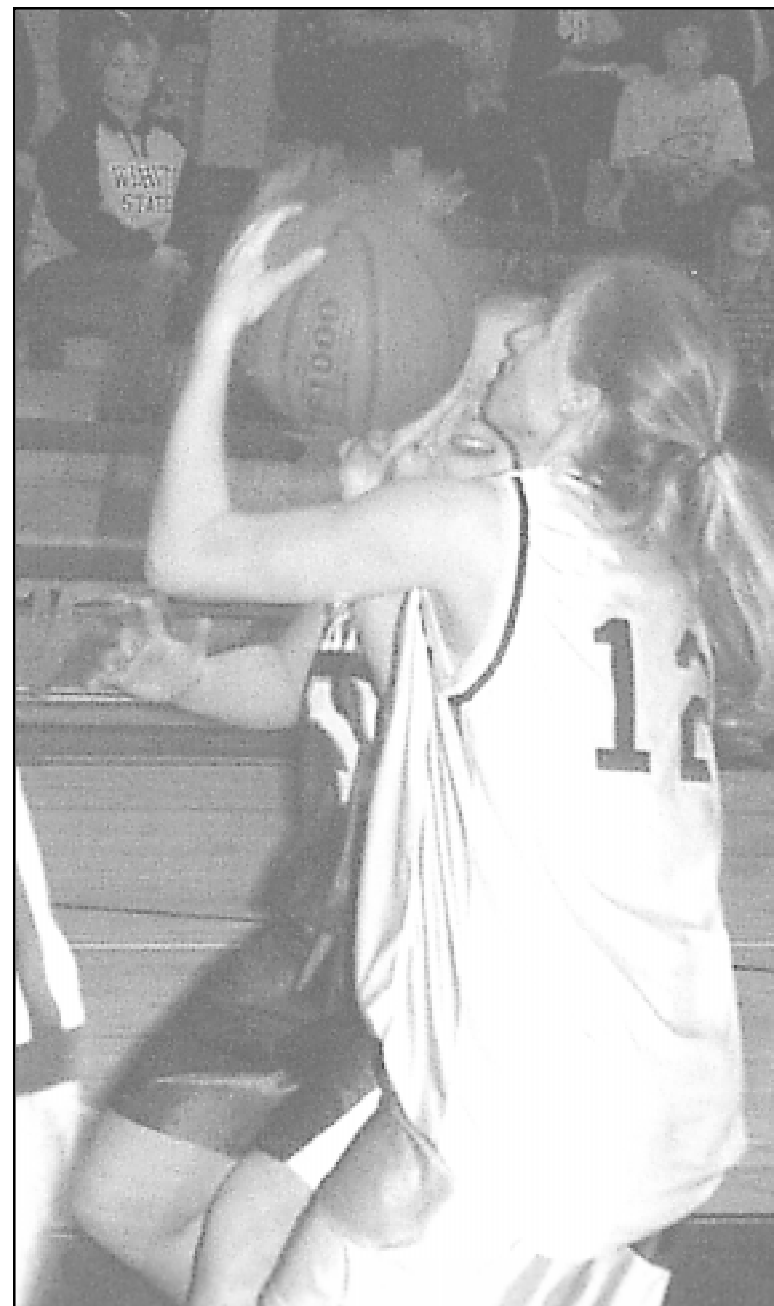
The leading scorer was Layla Woodall with 14 points and eight rebounds. Also contributing was Clarissa Unger with nine points and two boards.

Jared Dinkel had 18 points and six rebounds. Matt Augustine had 14 points, five rebounds and one assist.

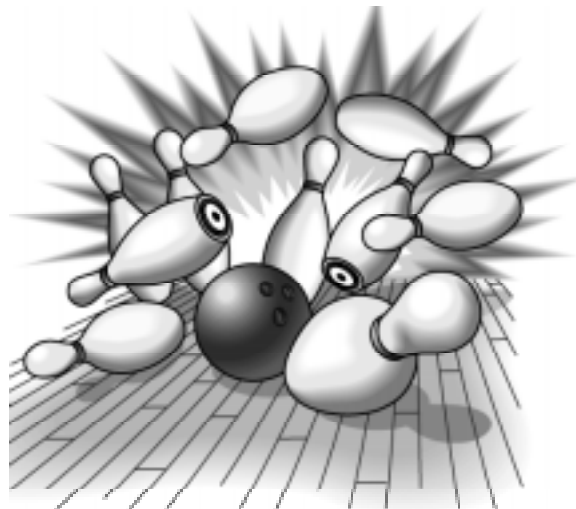
Christopher Finley had nine points and led the team with nine rebounds, along with an assist. Jordan Sharp had eight points, a board and a team-lead-
