

# Eagle wrestlers win close match with Indians

The Colby High School Eagle wrestling team won a 35-32 nailbiter against the Hoxie Indians Friday night in the Colby High School gym. They also beat Quinter 54-24 in double dual action.

The Eagles came into the match ranked seventh in Class 4A, facing the no. 1 ranked team in Class 3-2-1A and giving up a match at the 215-pound weight, but some big matches and a late match surprise by coach Mitch Beims put the Eagles in good position at the end.

Travis Powell started the match with a pin against Cale Farber with only 32 seconds left in the match at 103 and gave the Eagles their first six points.

Danny Mainus, ranked no. 1 in Class 4A, was wrestling Charlie Ochs, ranked second in 3-2-1A at 112.

At the end of two periods, the score was 2-1 Mainus. In the third period, Ochs injured his shoulder and couldn't continue, giving Colby another six point win.

Hoxie got on the board in the 119 pound match, placing Colby's Jesse Tibbles against Hoxie's no. 1 ranked Tyrel Spillman, who got a pin with 11 seconds left in the first round. The team score was 12-6, Colby.

Scottie Lindberg also faced a no. 1 ranked wrestler at 125 in Mat Gilliland. The pair battled to a 1-0 finish, with Gilliland coming out on top, making the team score 12-9 Colby.

Eric Luedke, ranked first at 130 for the Eagles had a tough match against Matt Schippers, ranked fourth in his class, but never fell behind.

He led 6-2 at the end of the first, 13-6 at the end of two and 13-8 at the final, giving Colby another three team points.

Justin Bell faced Jason Schippers, ranked third at 135. Schippers got a technical fall in the third round, giving Hoxie five team points.

Eagle Schuyler Sharpe got two

points in the second round on Kurt Shamberger at 140, enough to win the match 2-0 and make the team score 18-14 Colby.

Drue Herl faced Indian Cody Farber, ranked third at 145 pounds. Herl lost a tough 3-2 match. The team score was 18-17 Colby.

Colby's Rusty Raymo and Doug Campbell had a brawl in the second round of their 152-pound match, with both wrestlers scoring points.

Raymo trailed 4-1 at the end of the first round, but lit a fire in the second,



leading 9-7 at the buzzer. Campbell scored three quick points at the end of round three to win 10-9 and put the Indians ahead 20-18.

Tucker Olsen got a quick advantage on Hoxie's Alex Gaede and didn't give him any breaks, scoring a critical pin with 44 seconds left in the first round. The Eagles were ahead again 24-20.

Theo Kleinsorge faced Dustin Lewis at 171. The Hoxie wrestler pinned Kleinsorge with 56 seconds left in the second round.

In a surprise move, the Eagles substituted Jason Erickson for Brent Deibert at 189.

Although Erickson was pinned by Justin Cooper, the move paved the way for a technical fall by Deibert over Hoxie 215-pounder Fred Pratt.

With the team score 32-29 Hoxie and only one match remaining, Eric Seemann faced Devin Cooper at 275, needing at least a major decision to

give Colby a win. Seemann led 4-0 at the end of one period and 7-0 with two seconds left in the second.

That's when he made the score irrelevant by pinning Cooper and sealing a Colby win.

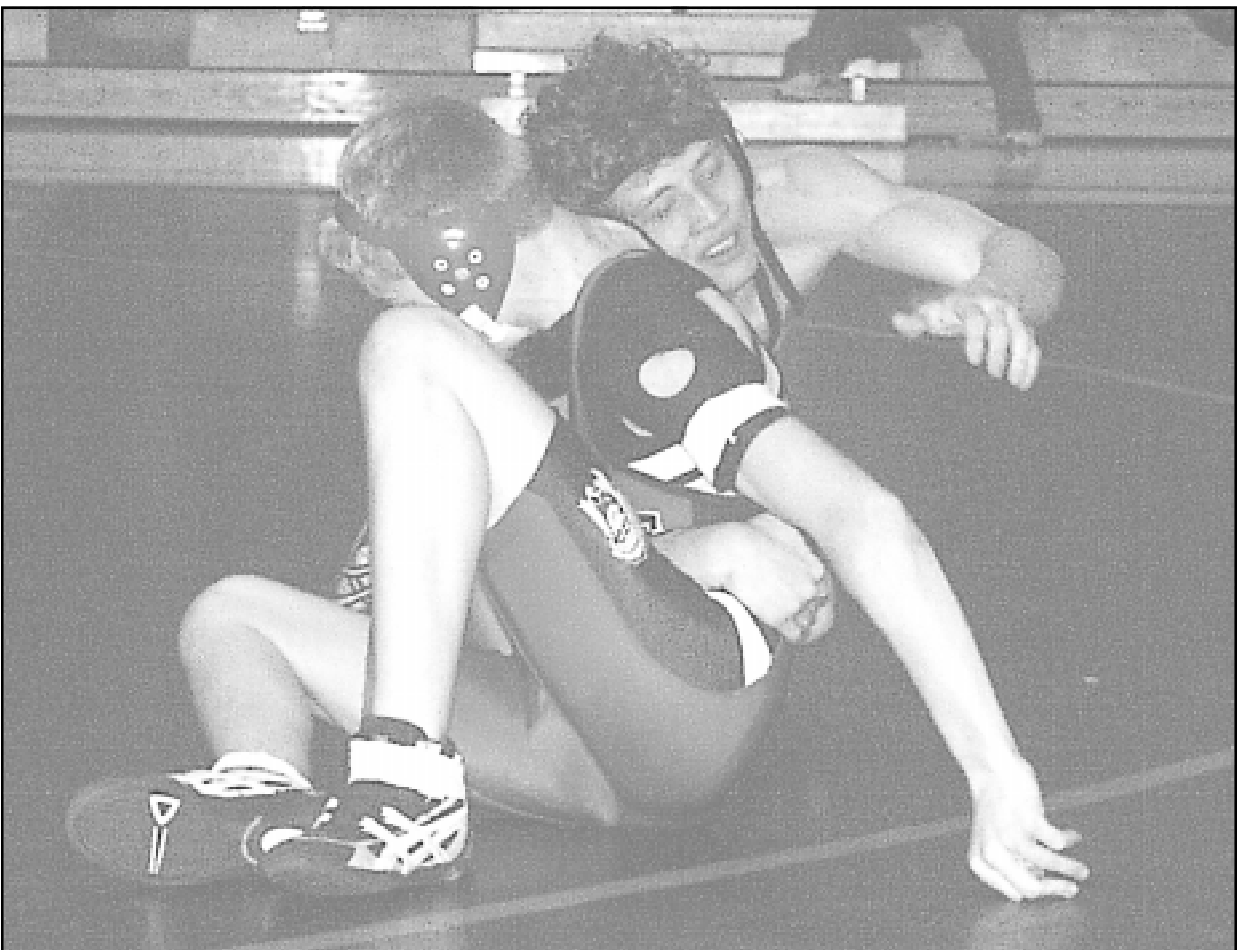
The Eagles are at Atwood Tuesday for a dual that starts at 5:30 p.m.

The Colby Lady Eagles gained momentum as they head into the Colby Orange & Black Classic basketball tournament this week with a big 67-39 victory over the Hoxie Lady Indians on Friday night.

Colby held a slim 12-9 lead at the first break but gained a commanding 39-19 lead at half-time and didn't look back.

Colby outscored Hoxie 17-6 in the third to lead 56-25 and finished off the game leading 67-39.

Ivy Ramsey scored 16 of her 18 points in the first half to lead the scoring for the Lady Eagles. Ramsey also led the team by recording six teals, in addition to three rebounds and an assist.

Summar Stephens added 14 points, a team high five assists, three steals and two rebounds.

Samantha Wolf connected for nine points, grabbed one rebound and had two assists. Breann Hart contributed eight points, one board and two steals.

Emily Sloan tossed in six points, hauled down four rebounds and blocked one shot. Amanda Seemann scored five points, recorded one steal and an assist.
