The first through third grade Little Cagers performed Monday night during half-time of the Colby Community College women's basketball game.

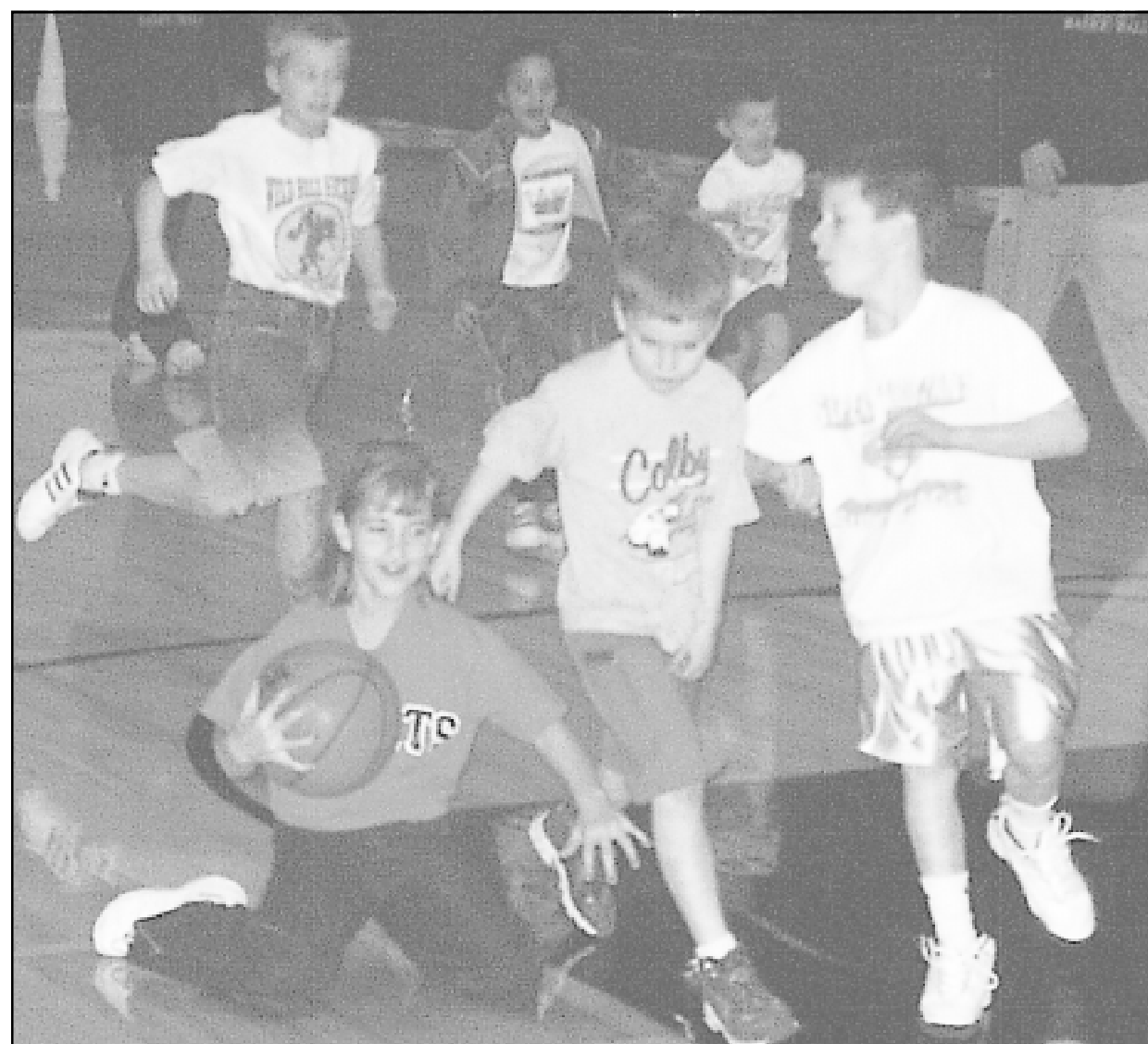
