

Trojan wrestling team falls to third ranked Iowa Central

FORT DODGE, Iowa—The Colby Community College Trojan wrestling team felt the loss of Matt Murray, who had a death in his family, and Bryan Miller, to illness, Thursday as they fell 42-6 to the no. 3 ranked team in the nation, Iowa Central Community College in Fort Dodge, Iowa.

Colby gave up three forfeits from the start. In addition to Miller at 133, who had beaten Kurt McGonegle in Colby at the tournament of champions earlier this month, and Murray, who had done the same to Paul Collum, the team lost Derek Daugherty at 285-pounds to

academic ineligibility.

Colby's only win came when Henry Martinez countered a headlock and pinned John Hagerty two minutes into the 165-pound match.

Derek Jones, ranked sixth at 125, had a shot at Justin McClintock, ranked fourth, but couldn't pull it off, losing 9-4.

O.T. Johnson, at 149, was leading 3-2 when Steve Summer got a takedown

with only five seconds left in the match and won 4-3.

Shannon Ford also had a shot against Brenon Chyma, an All-American at 174 last season, but was pinned late in round two.

"Injuries and two ineligibilities at semester have hurt us," said Lampe. The Trojans will dual Minnesota West in Worthington, Minn. today and will be in the Bluejay

Open, also in Worthington, Saturday.
