magical illusions with laser beams, a cowboy kicks up a luminescent rope-spinning display, and an audience member escapes from a straitjacket.

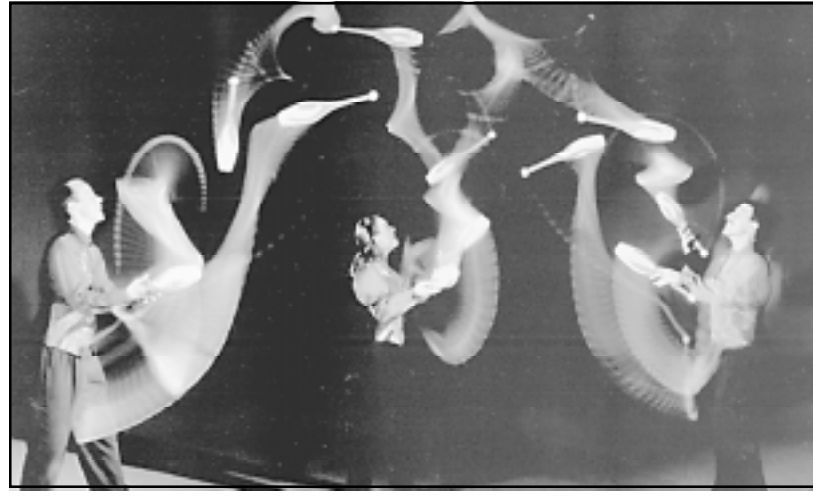

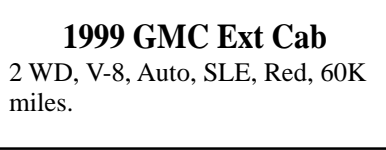
