Three Brewster girls were in double figures. Alicia Collett with 24, Andrea Horney had 18 and Sara Luckert had 10.

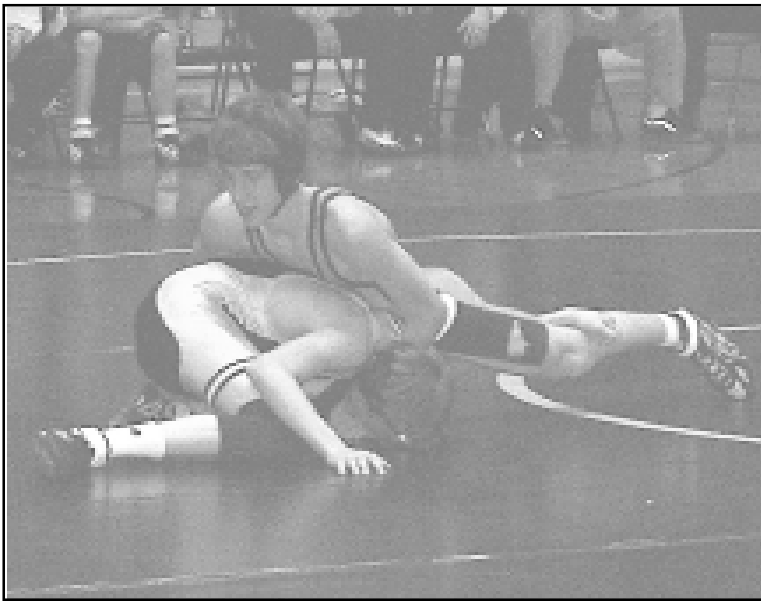
Kristi Jamison had six. Amber Fulwider and Miranda Starns had two each.

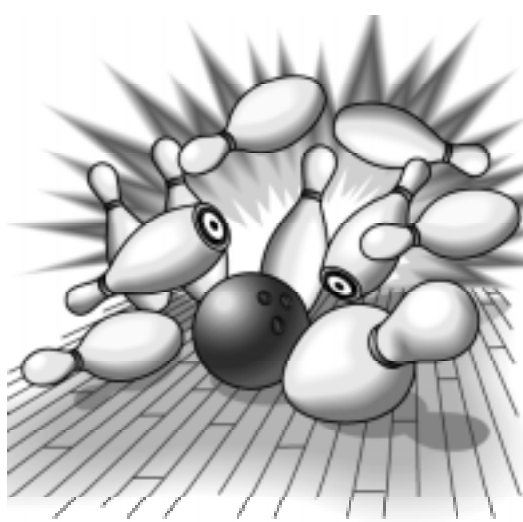
