<u>Wrong team hits the dirt</u>

Dodge City wins shootout with Trojan men

Problem is, however, the wrong team hit the dirt.

That assault on an otherwise disciplined and seemingly unflappable Dodge City bunch caught the attention of a crowd of more than 1,100, bringing them into the game in the final min-

The crowd's involvement spilled over early in the second half when Dodge City came on like Colby came within 2 points, 46-44. From then on in it was a dogfight with both teams showing their teeth and

Colby never took a lead in the game until the clock showed 1:42 left, thanks to a Dedric Spooner tip-in. Seconds later, however, the Trojans were whistled for a foul on Dodge City's Jason Ingram, who, unfortunately, was in the process of shooting a 3-pointer. Ingram toed the line and sank all three charity tosses, moving Dodge City into a 75-74 lead with under 1 minute to

play. The crowd's support was growing louder.

Keyon Williams, on the Trojans'

next possession, saw Pierre Tucker in Weskan basketball standout — con- Mike Wolters 1-20-03; Brent Brooks position for a sure shot and Tucker responded with a 15-footer to give the Trojans the lead once again, 76-75.

Thirty-one ticks remained on the clock. Dodge City played the clock down to 6.2 seconds and called a time out. Colby followed with a time out of its own.

The stage was set for one final attempt at the basket. Dodge's Kerbrell Brown went in for a driving layup and the visitors were up 77-76 with 2.1 seconds remaining. The Trojans got the ball in, the buzzer sounded and the shoot out was all over.

But the wrong team hit the dirt.

Keyon Williams was Colby top scorer with 16 points, 3 boards, 3 assists and 6 steals. Pierre Tucker added 15 points and had 6 rebounds. Dedric Spooner put in 14 points and had 10 rebounds. Joe Williams scored 12.

For Dodge City, Jason Ingram led the way with 22 points. Dodge City, incidentally, was 11 of 17 from 3-point range, with Todd Okeson - former


