Northwest Kansas League streak alive; Hoxie wins another championship

Colby Free Press HAYS — Hoxie High School gave the Northwest Kansas League their seventh consecutive wrestling championship in at least one division by scoring 140 points Saturday at Busch Gross Coliseum in Hays in the 3-2-1A State Wrestling Tournament.

Previous winners were: 2001, Colby, 4A; 2000, Goodland, 4A; 1999, Hoxie, 3-2-1A; 1998, Hoxie, 3-2-1A; 1997, Goodland, 4A; 1996, St. Francis

Colby Free Press WICHITA --- Colby High School's wrestling team finished fourth at the Class 4A State Tournament in Wichita over the weekend on the strength of one first place and two second place finishes

The Eagles 77 points put them behind the champion Clay Center, with 104 1/2 points, Goodland with 100 points and Columbus with 95 points.

In other northwest Kansas action, Norton finished fifth with 72 points and Scott City finished 15th with 47 points.

Colby's champion was 112-pounder Danny Mainus, a junior. Two other Eagle wrestlers made the finals, 130pound junior Eric Luedke and 140pound sophomore Schuyler Sharpe. Both ended up with second place medals

Mainus beat Coffeyville's Brandon Tracy 12-1 and Abilene's Josh Peterson 15-4. He then pinned Ulysses' Joey Ortiz in the semi-finals and beat Goodland's Blayze Bahe in the final round 5-1.

Mainus had beaten Ortiz 1-0 in the semi-finals at the regional tournament in Larned the week before and had been beaten 5-2 by Bahe in the championship of that tournament.

Luedke beat J.D Horton, Atchison and Jeremy Terrell, Rose Hill by fall in the first two rounds. He then beat Clay Center's Danny Grater 4-1, but lost a




