Beat Goodland 55-32 Thursday

The 20-2 Colby Lady Eagles are just one game away from going to the state tournament in Salina next week, thanks to a big win over the Goodland Cowgirls in the semifinals of the Class 4A Substate Tournament at Pratt Community College Thursday evening, 55-32.

The Eagles will take on Scott City for the Pratt Substate championship at 6 p.m. Saturday. Scott City beat Larned, 35-33.

The Eagles exploded in the first half, scoring 20 points in each of the first two quarters while holding Goodland to just 11 points in the first half.

Leading the team in scoring was Ivy Ramsey with 22 points. She was also credited with 6 rebounds, 2 steals and 2 assists. Summar Stephens connected on four 3-point shots and finished the game with 18 points, 6 boards, 3 steals and 1 assist.

Bethanie Linden hit for 5 points, led the team with 8 rebounds, stole the ball 3 times and was the assist leader with 4.

Brianna Swafford and Emily Sloan scored 3 points each. Sloan also pulled down 3 rebounds and 2 steals.

Swafford had 3 rebounds, 1 steal and 3 assists.

Amanda Seemann and Samantha Wolf both finished with 2 points apiece. Seemann also pulled down 3 rebounds and got 2 steals. Wolf grabbed a rebound and had 1 assist.

Breann Hart and Desiree Sharp each had 2 rebounds. Shawna Cox also saw action.

Trojan Ladies fall to Barton, 87-75

After trailing 49-28 at halftime, the Colby Community College Lady Trojans made several runs at Barton County, coming within 3 points on a few occasions, but Barton County prevailed in the final Jayhawk West Conference game of the season for the Lady Trojans, 87-75, in the Colby Community Building Wednesday night.
